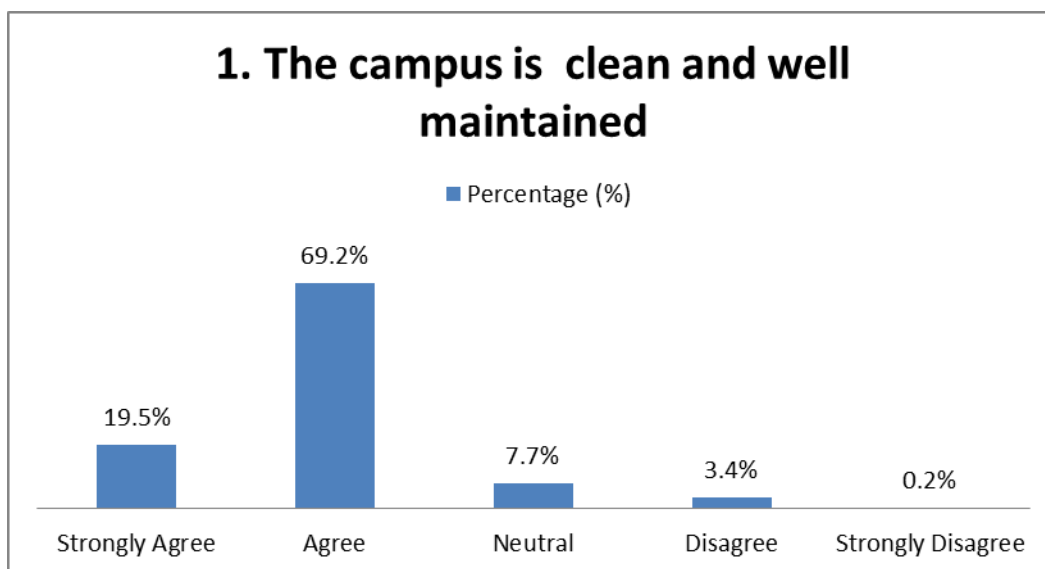


Figure 1: Whether the campus is clean and well maintained

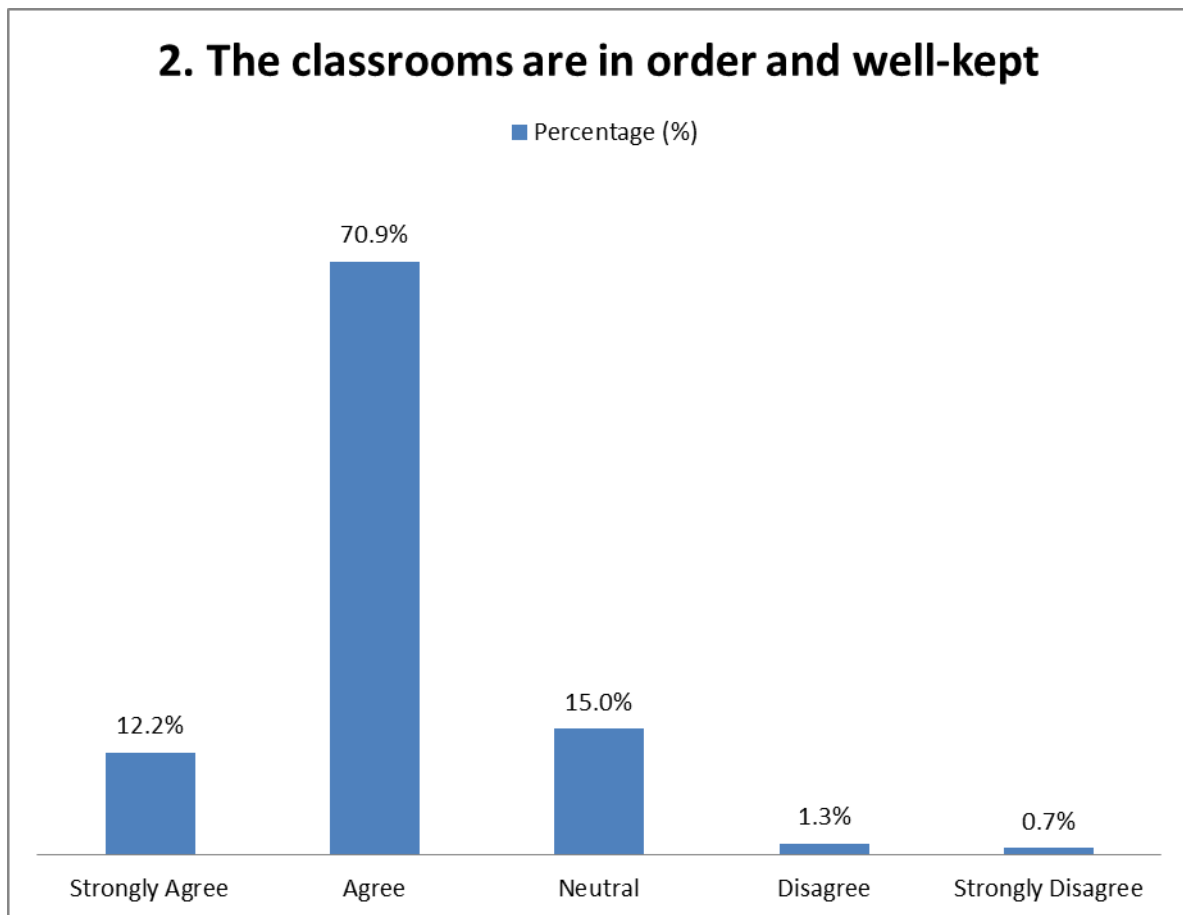


Figure 2: Whether the class rooms are in order and well-kept

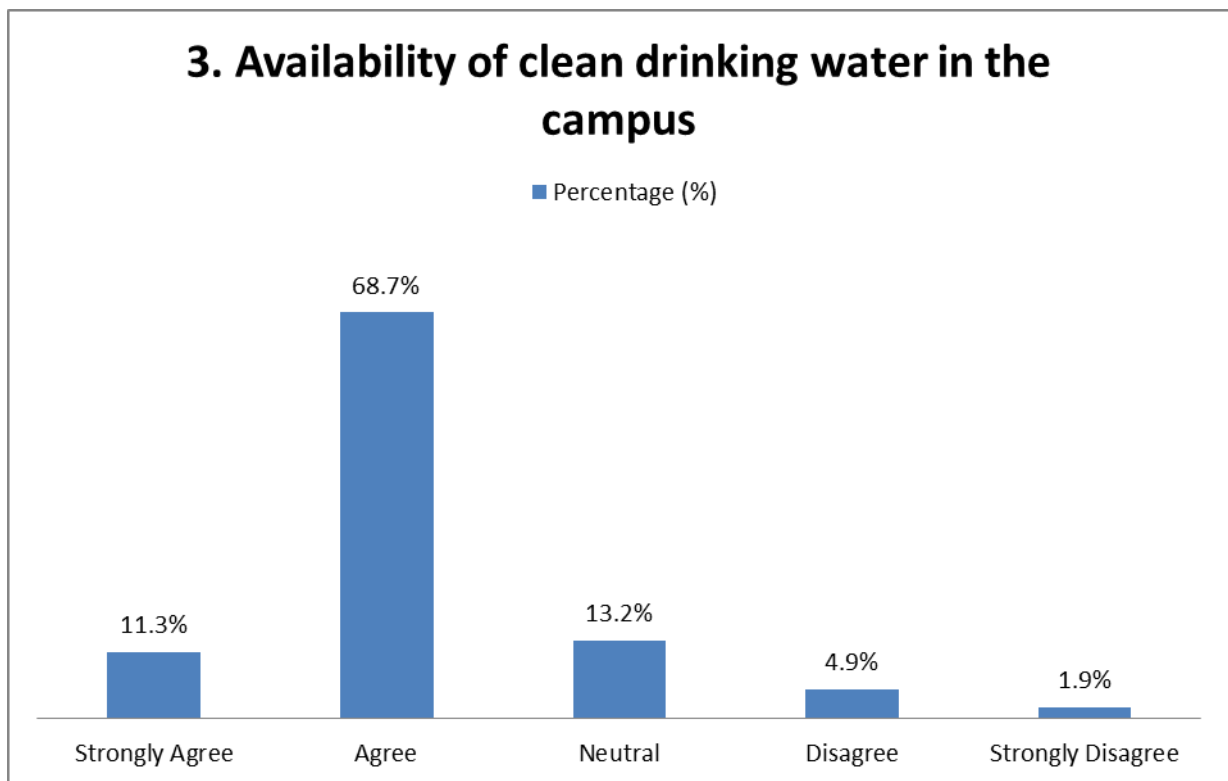


Figure 3: Availability of clean drinking water in the campus

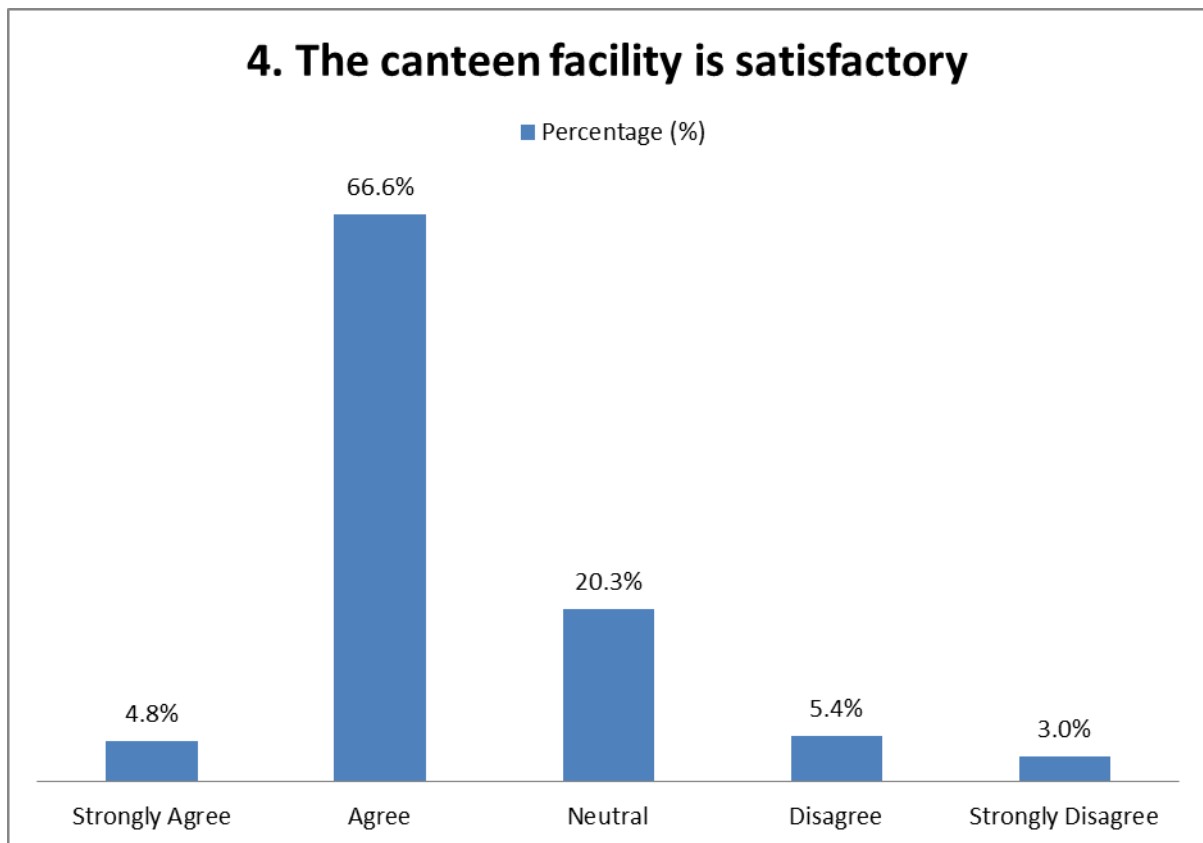


Figure 4: Whether the canteen facility is satisfactory

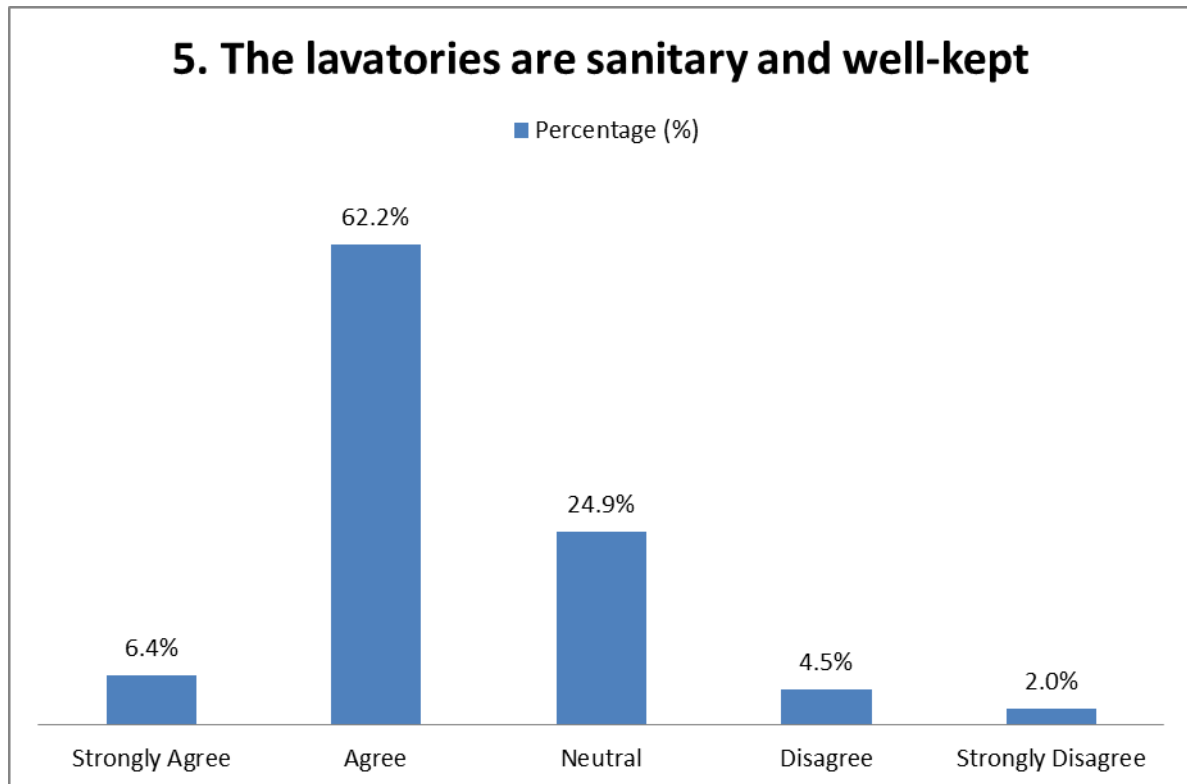


Figure 5: Whether the lavatories are sanitary and well-kept

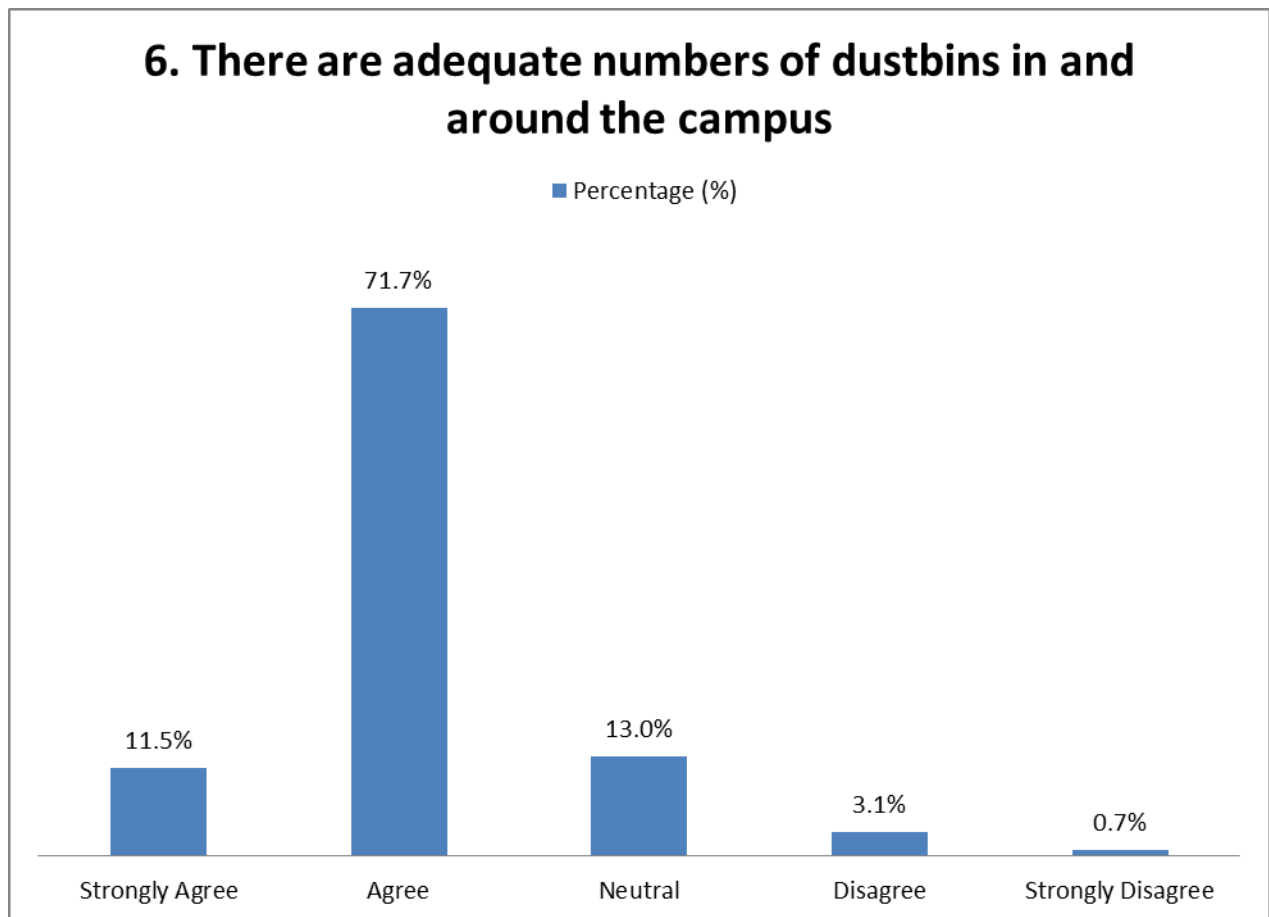


Figure 6: Whether there are adequate numbers of dustbins in and around the campus

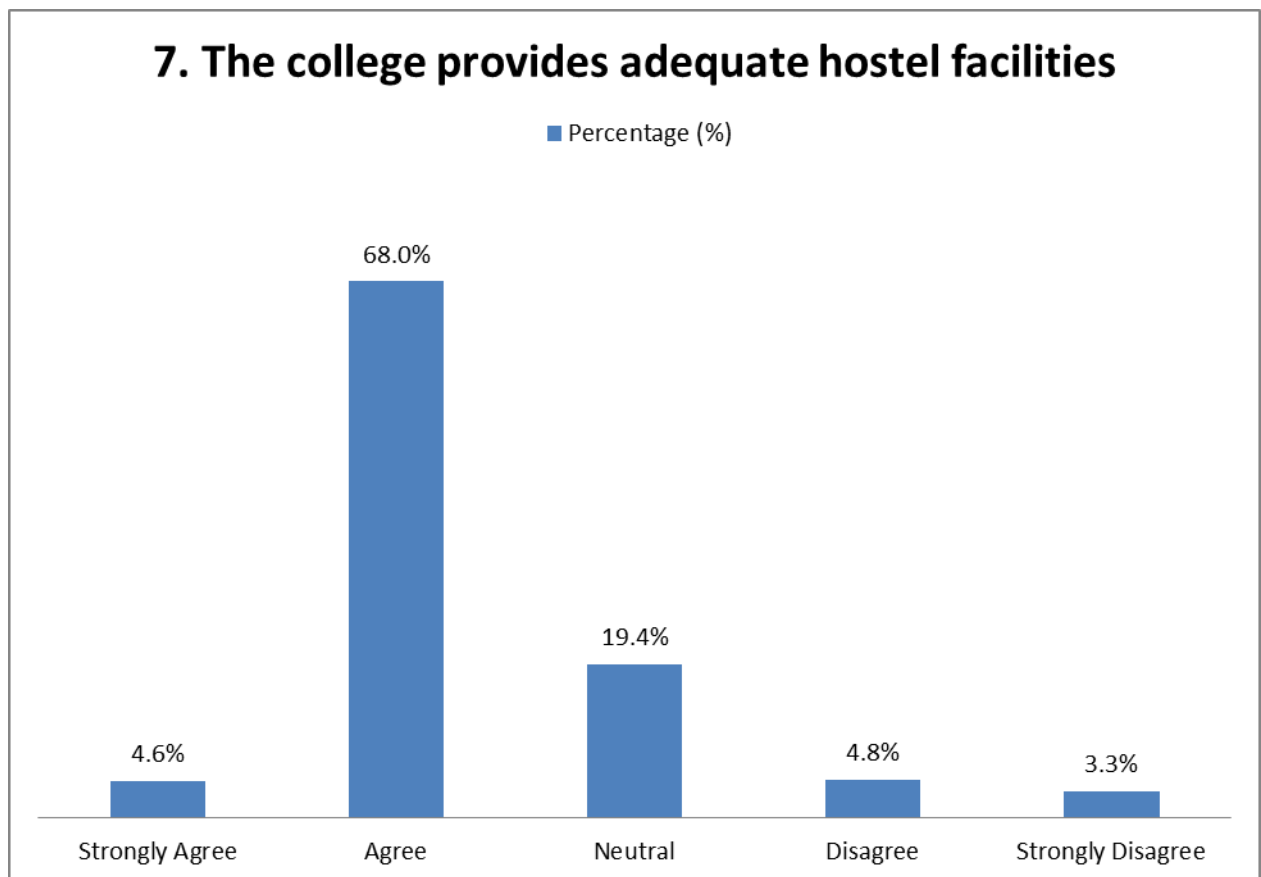


Figure 7: Whether the college provides adequate hostel facilities

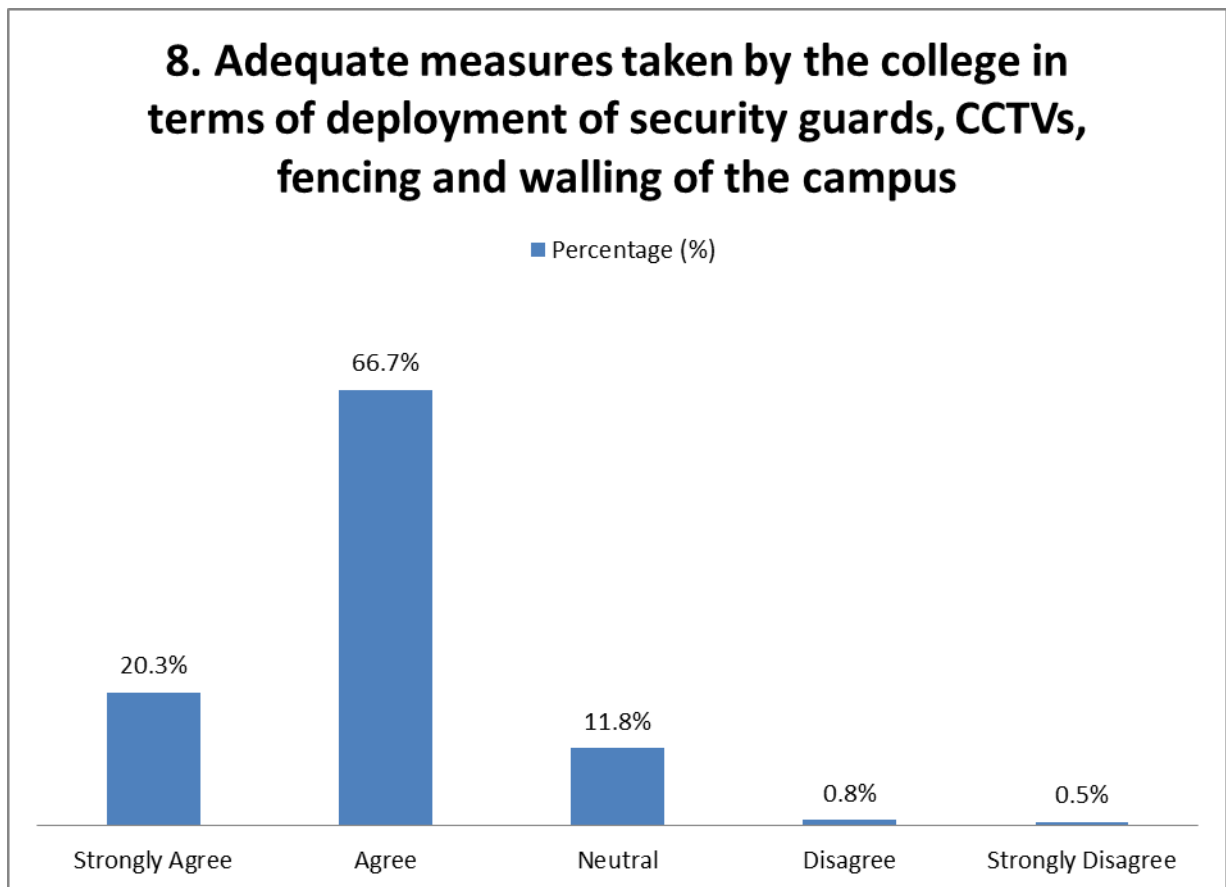


Figure 8: Whether adequate measures taken by the college in terms of deployment of security guards, CCTVs, fencing and walling of the campus

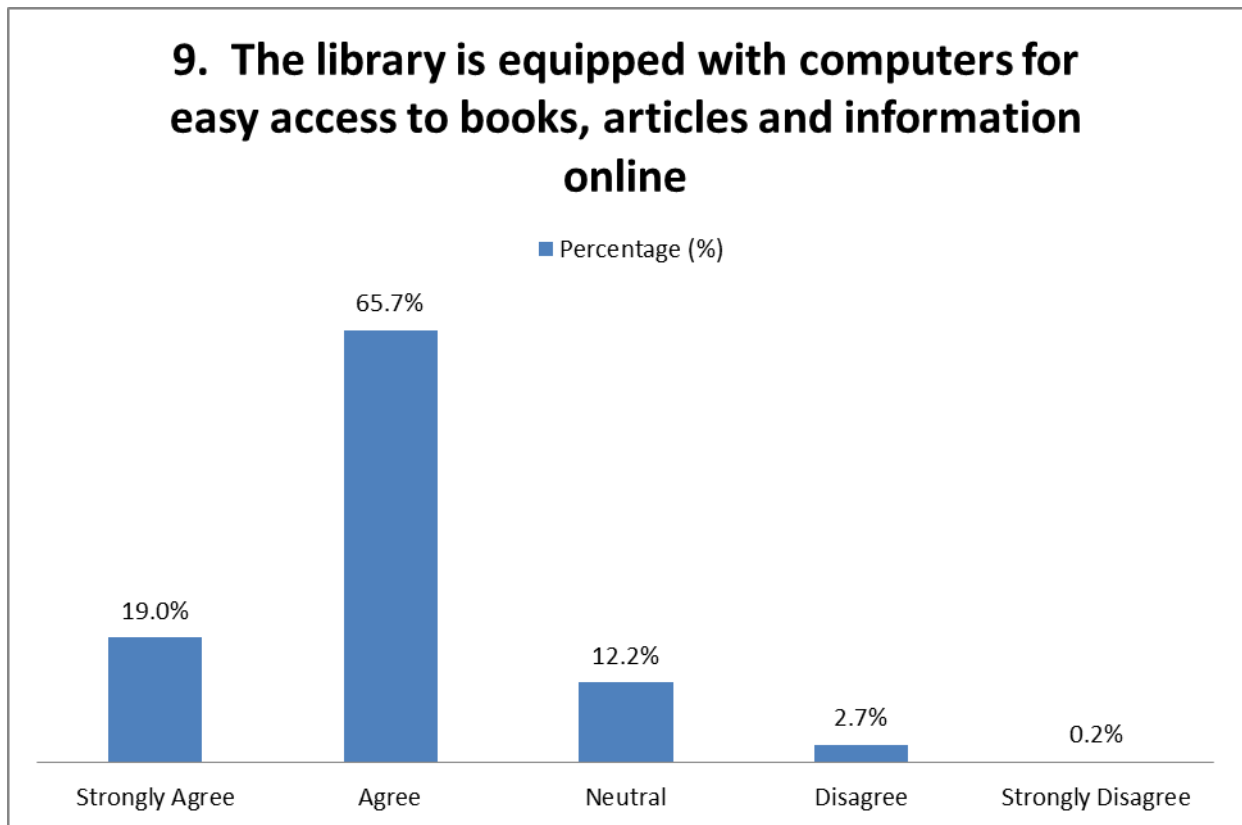


Figure 9: Whether the library is equipped with computers for easy access to books, articles and information online

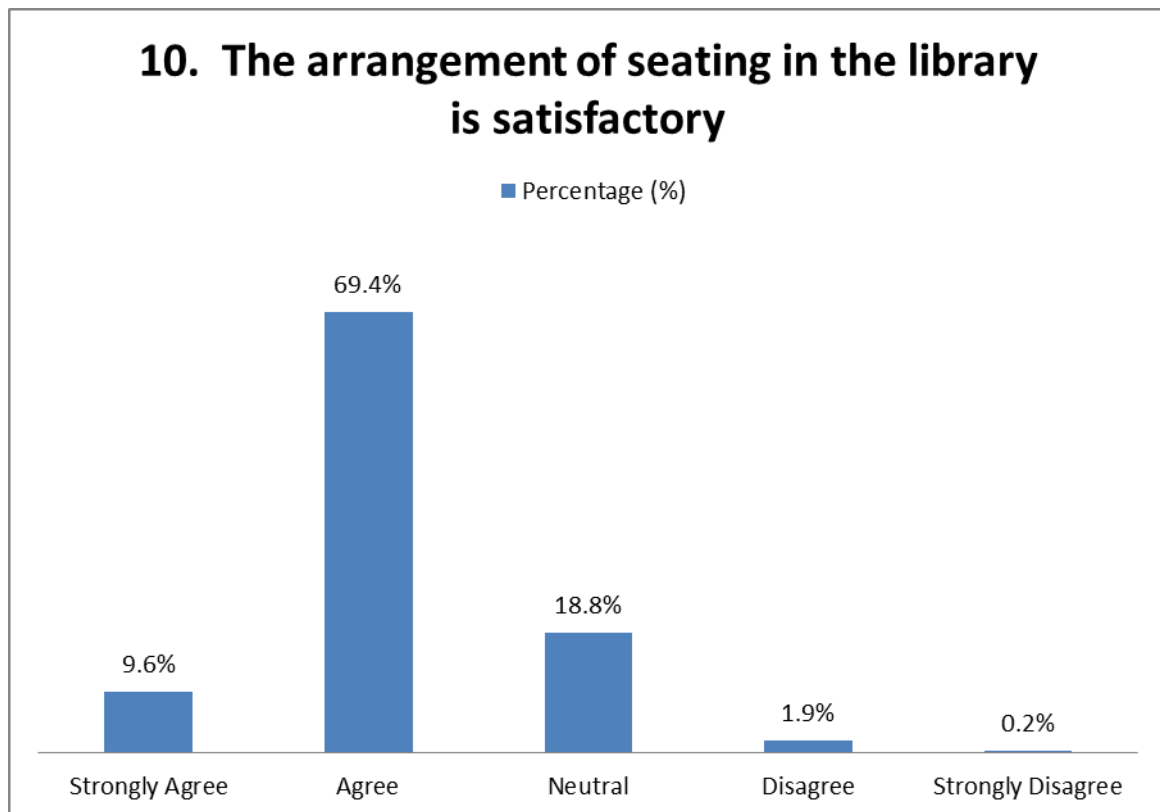


Figure 10: Whether the arrangement of seating in the library is satisfactory

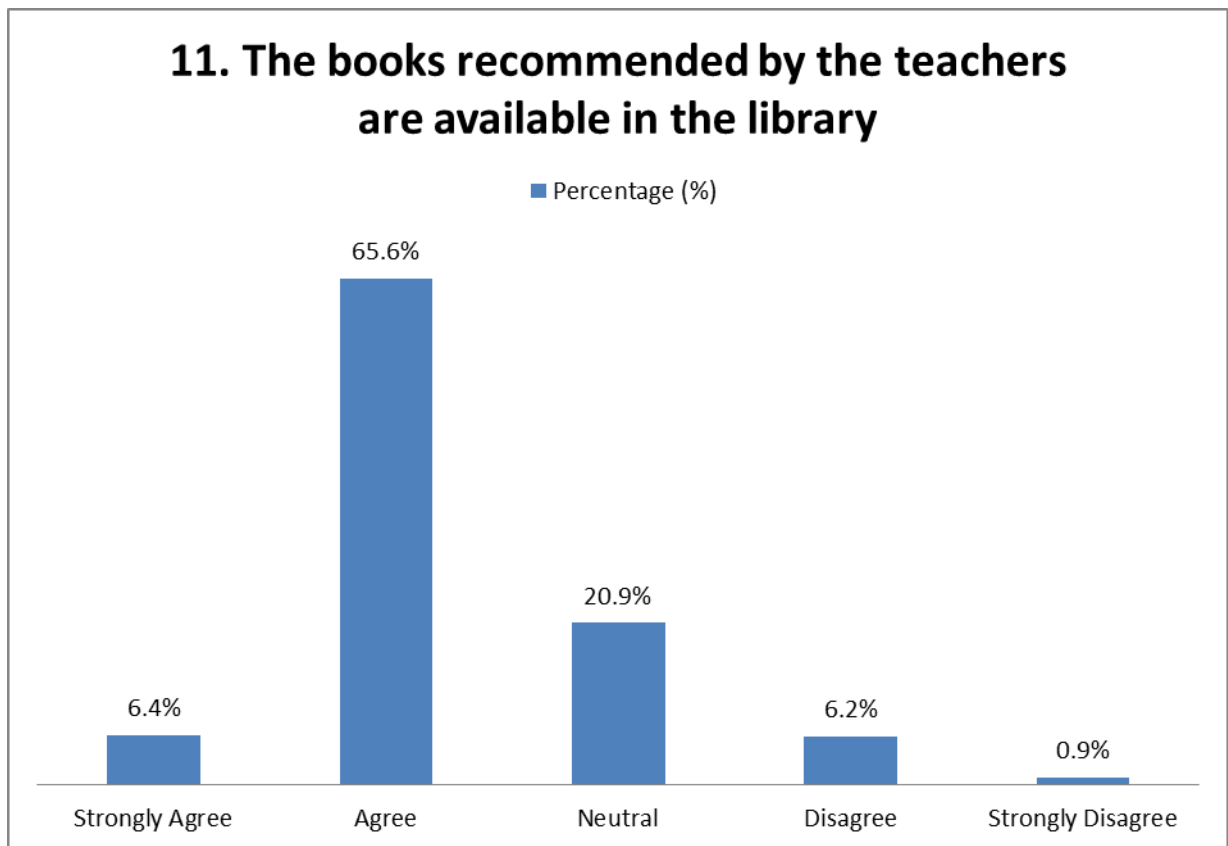


Figure 11: Whether the books recommended by the teachers are available in the library

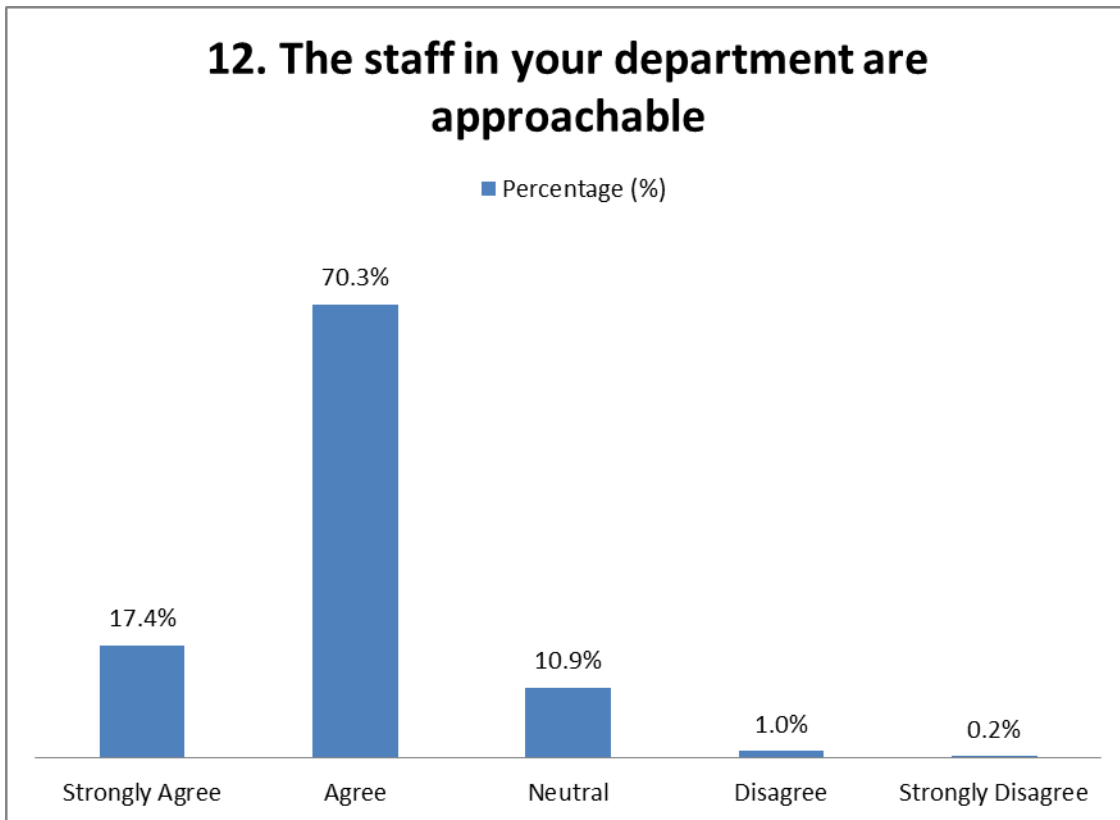


Figure 12: Whether the staffs in department are approachable

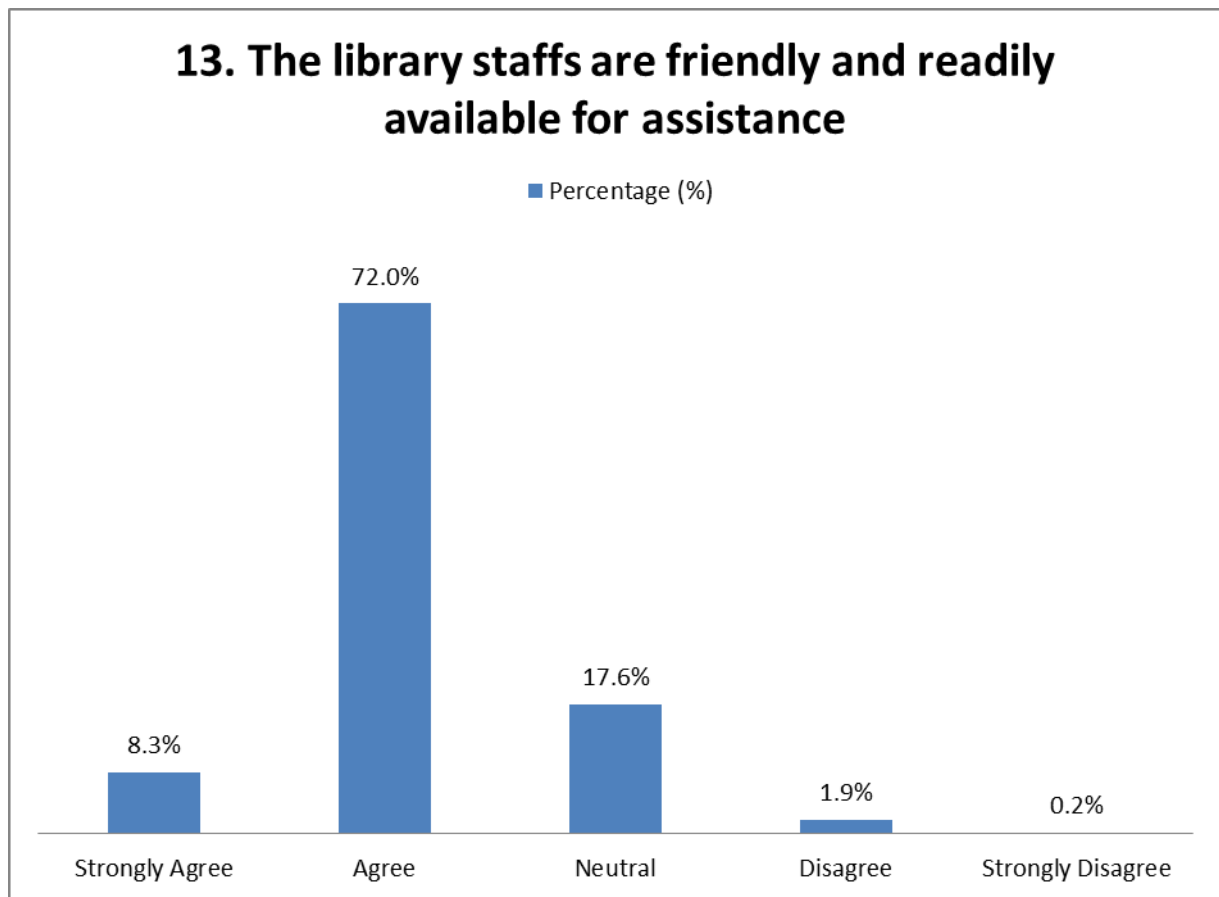


Figure 13: Whether the library staffs are friendly and readily available for assistance

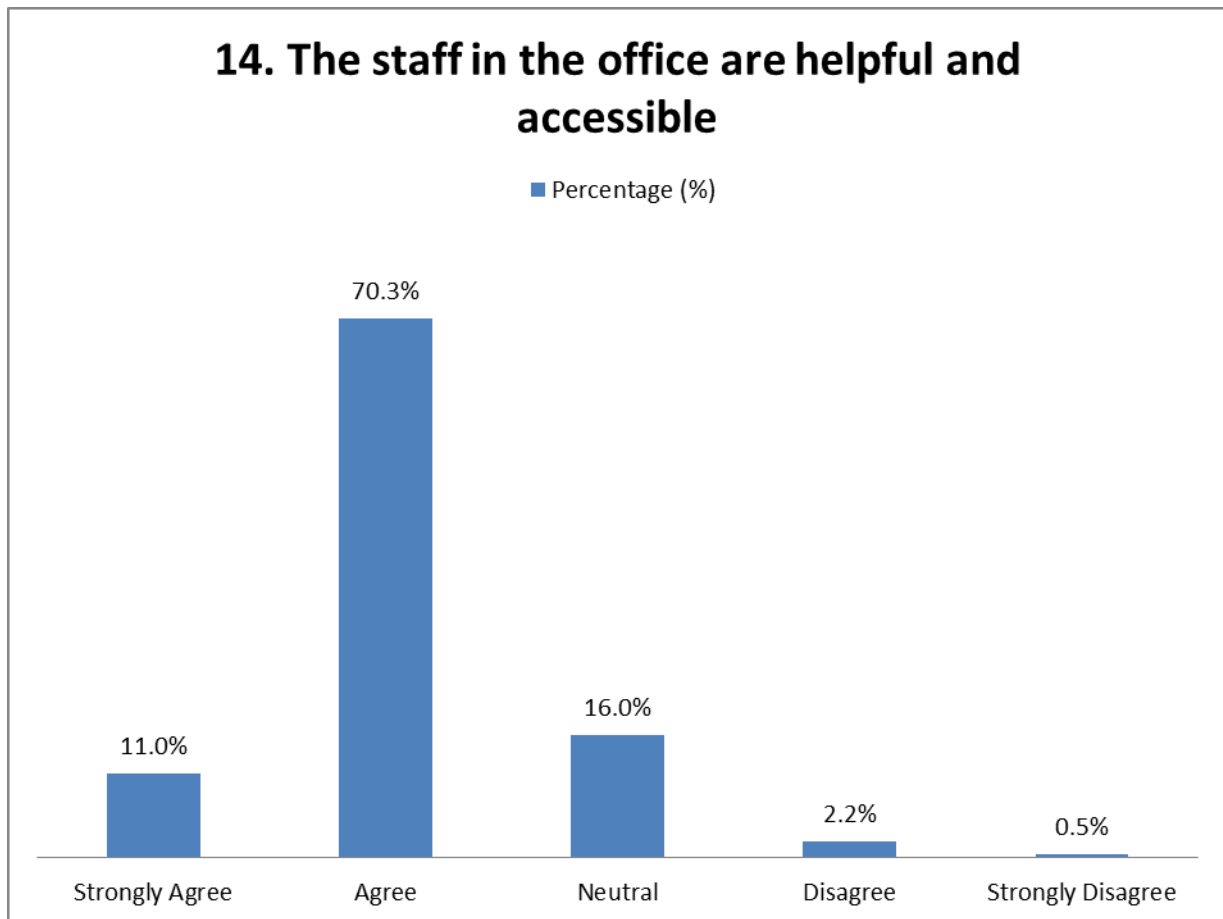


Figure 14: Whether the staffs in the office are helpful and accessible

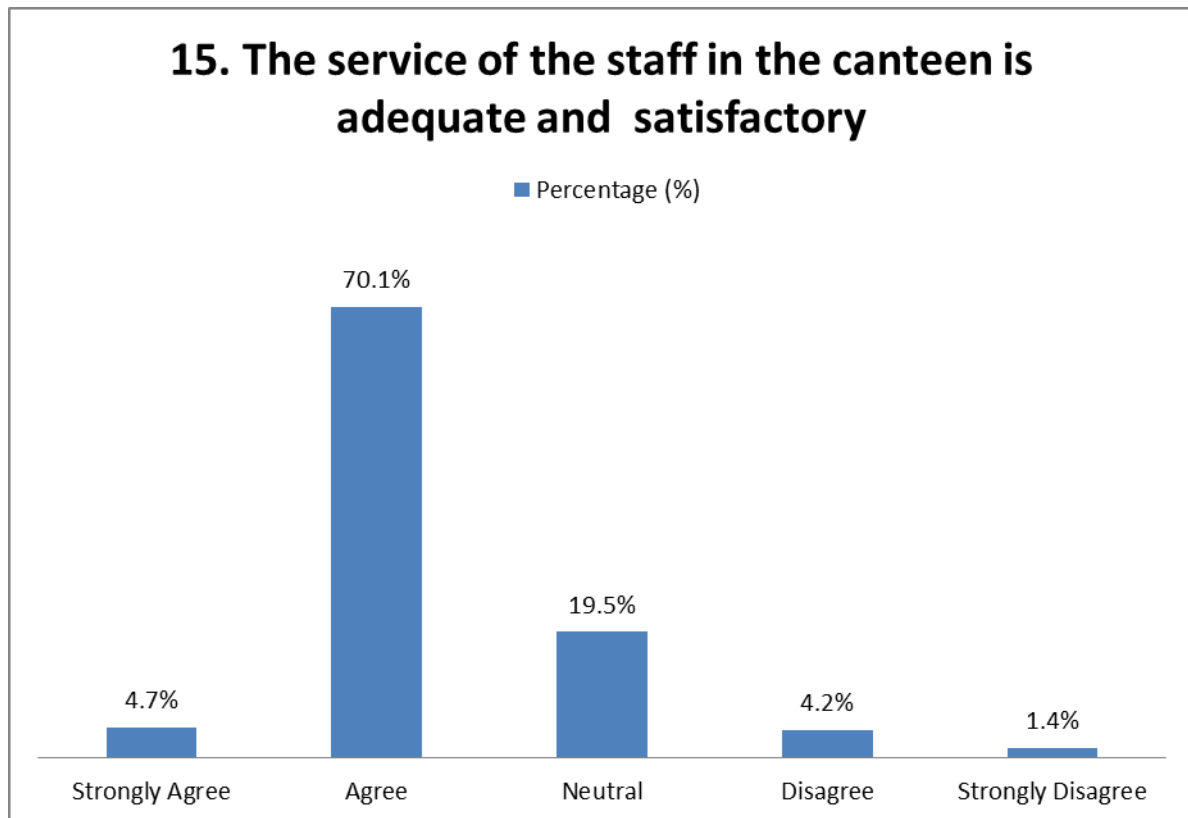


Figure 15: Whether the service of the staff in the canteen is adequate and satisfactory

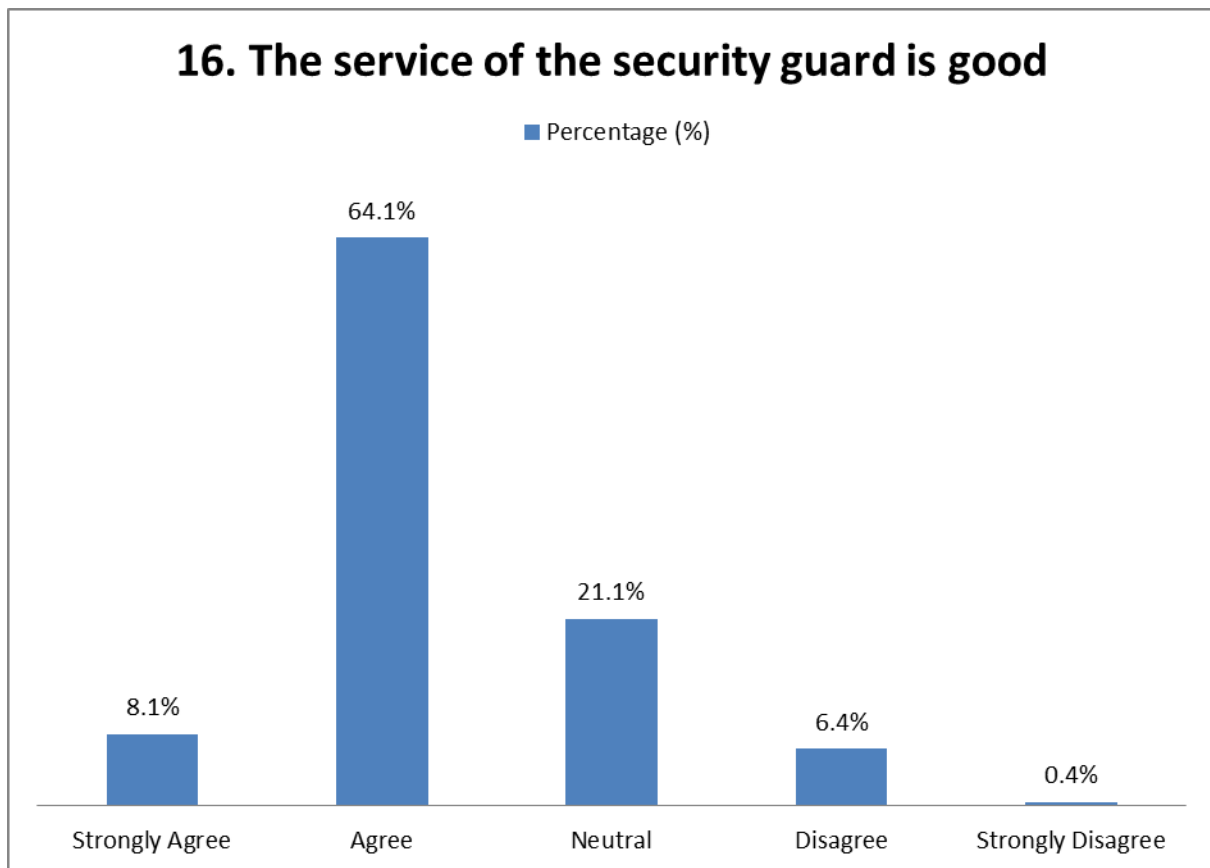


Figure 16: Whether the service of the security guard is good

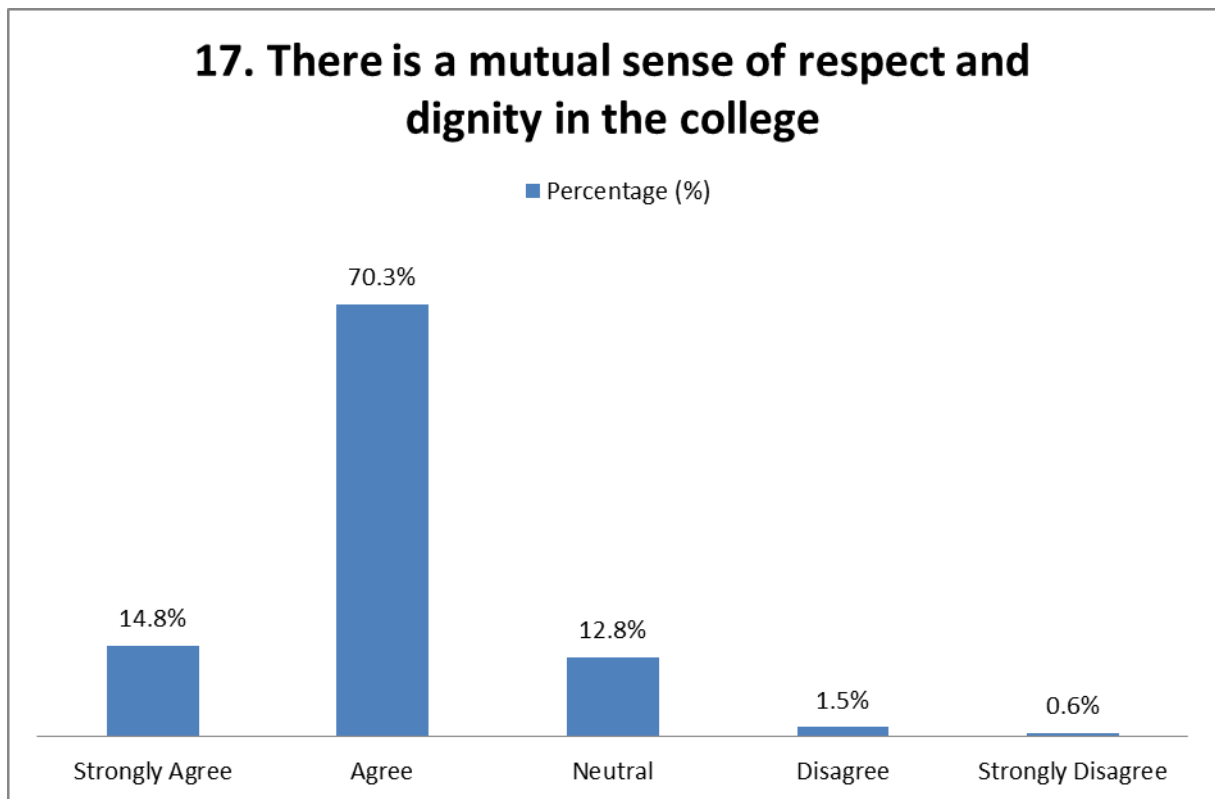


Figure 17: Whether there is a mutual sense of respect and dignity in the college

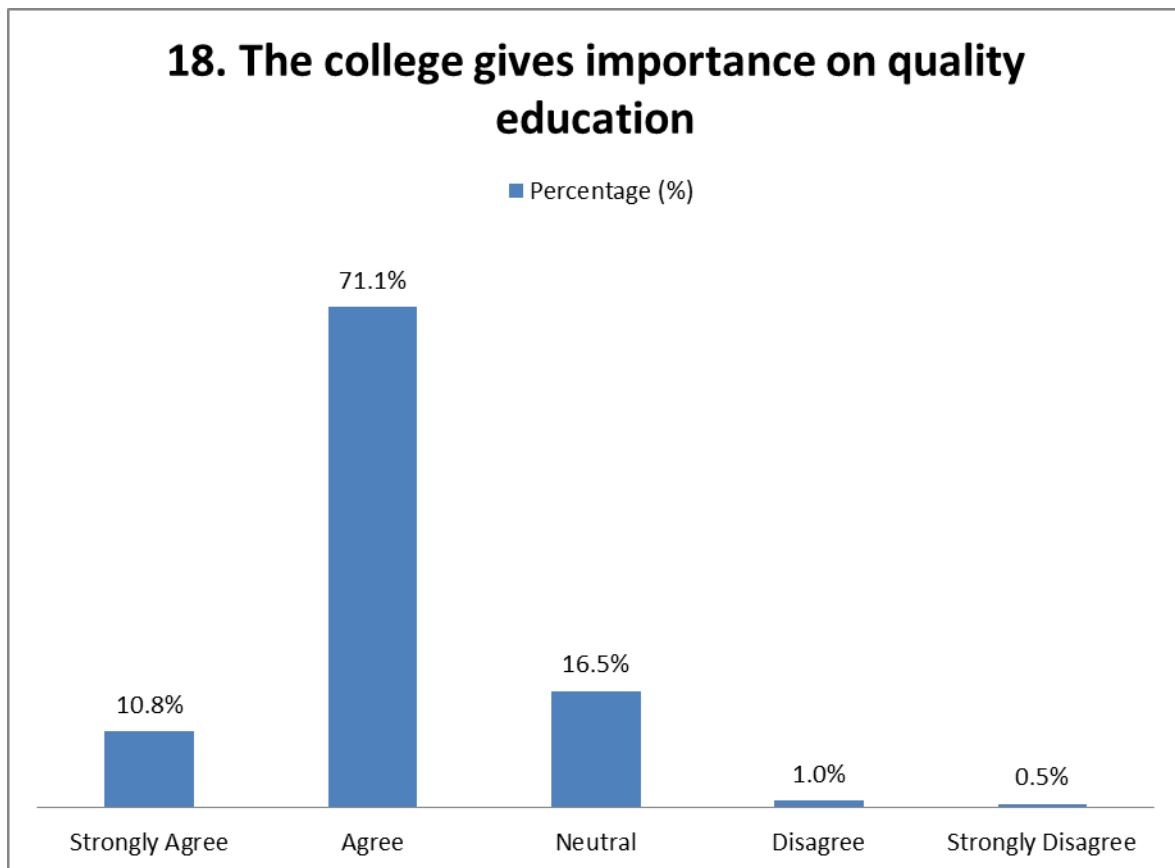


Figure 18: Whether the college gives importance on quality education

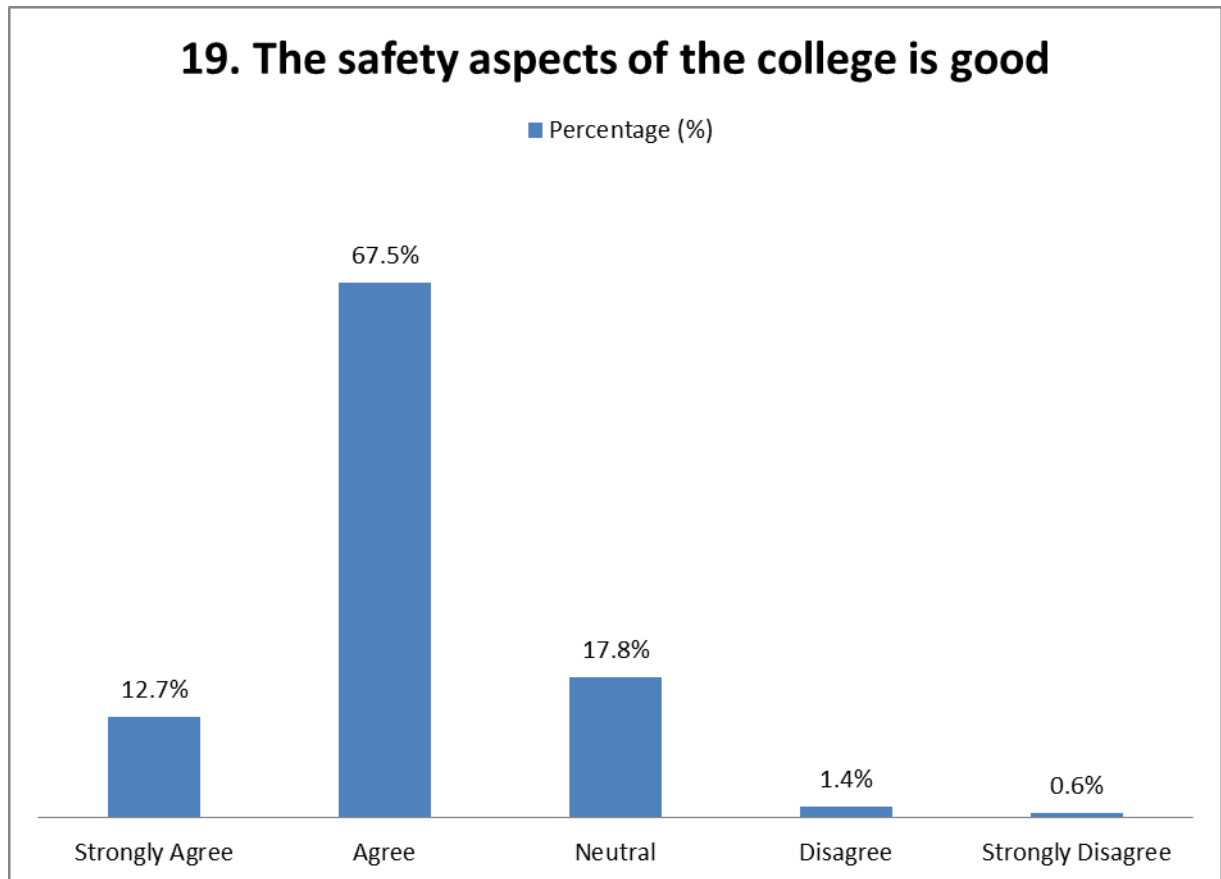


Figure 19: Whether the safety aspects of the college is good

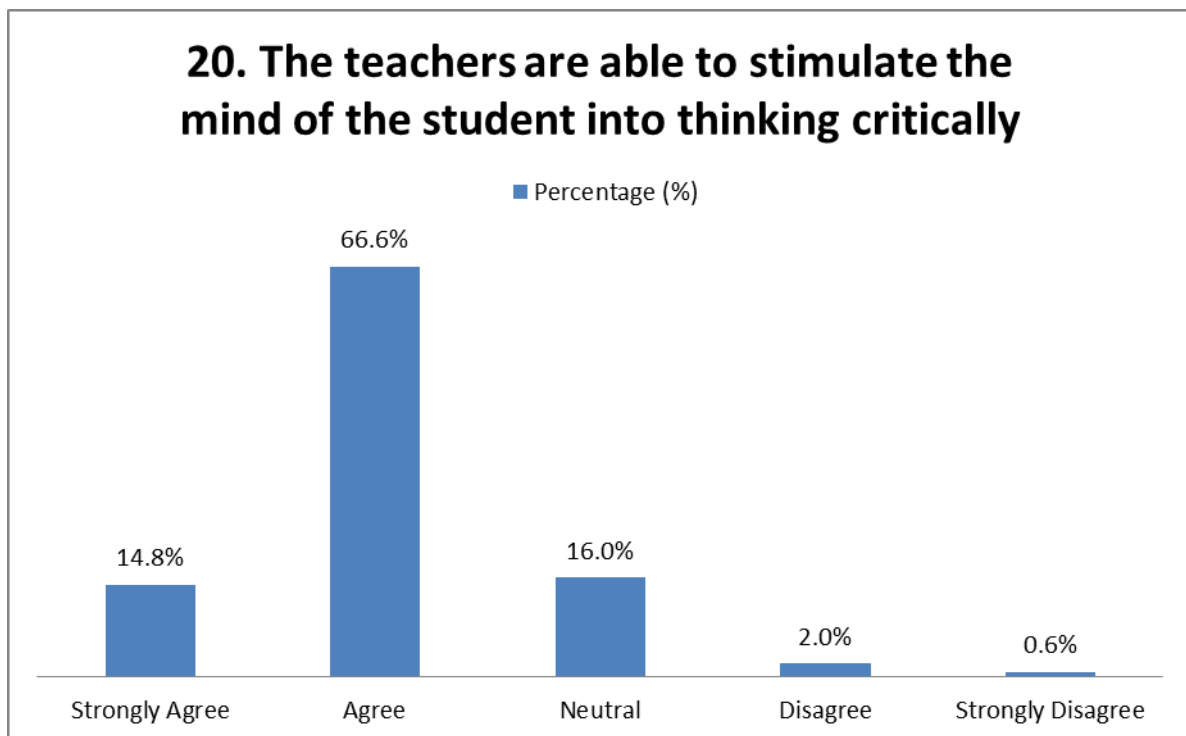


Figure 20: Whether the teachers are able to stimulate the mind of the student into thinking critically

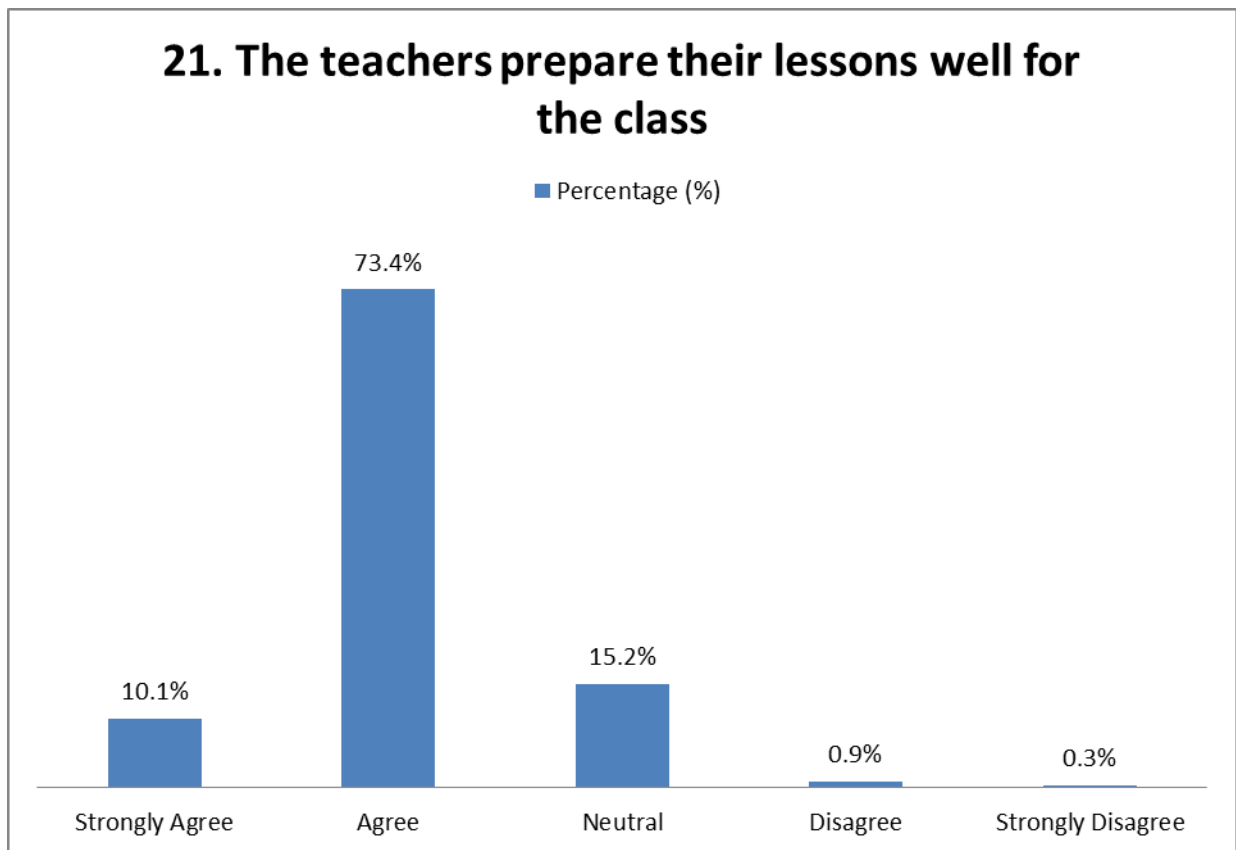


Figure 21: Whether the teachers prepare their lessons well for the class

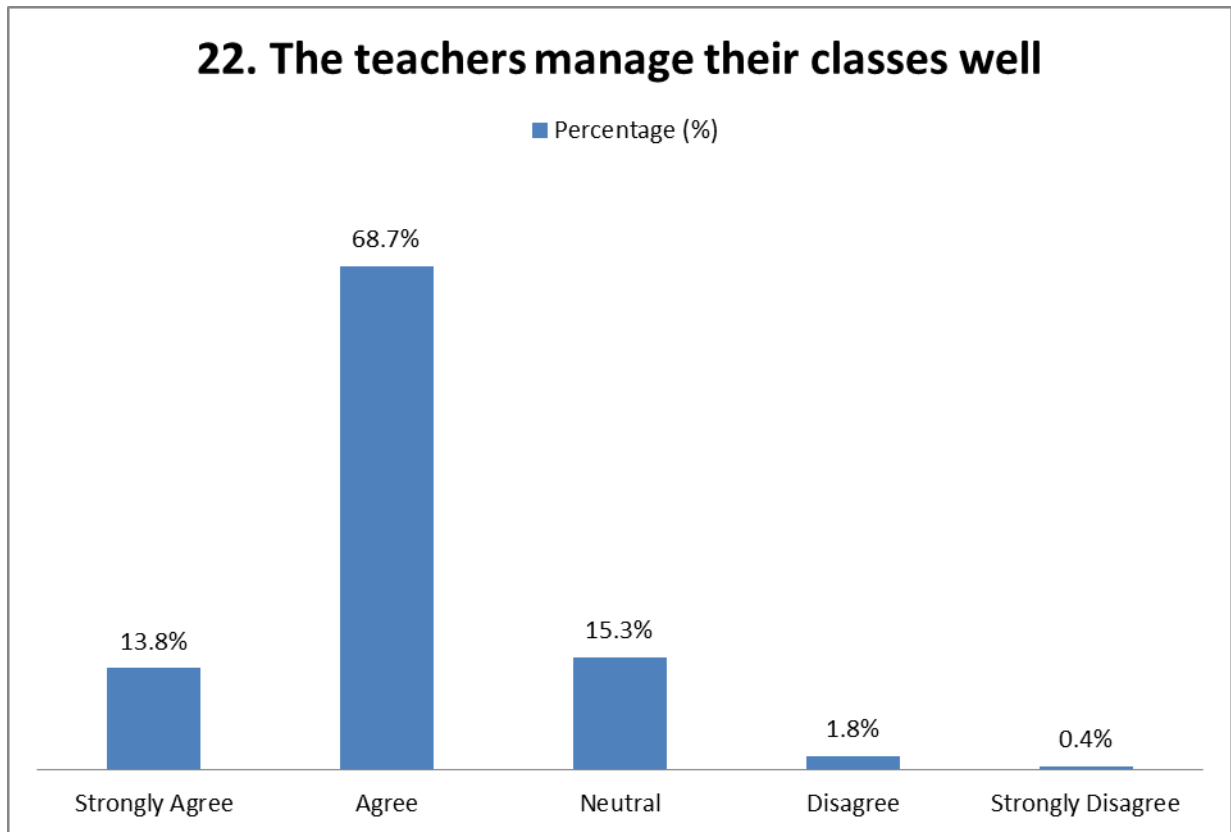


Figure 22: Whether the teachers manage their classes well

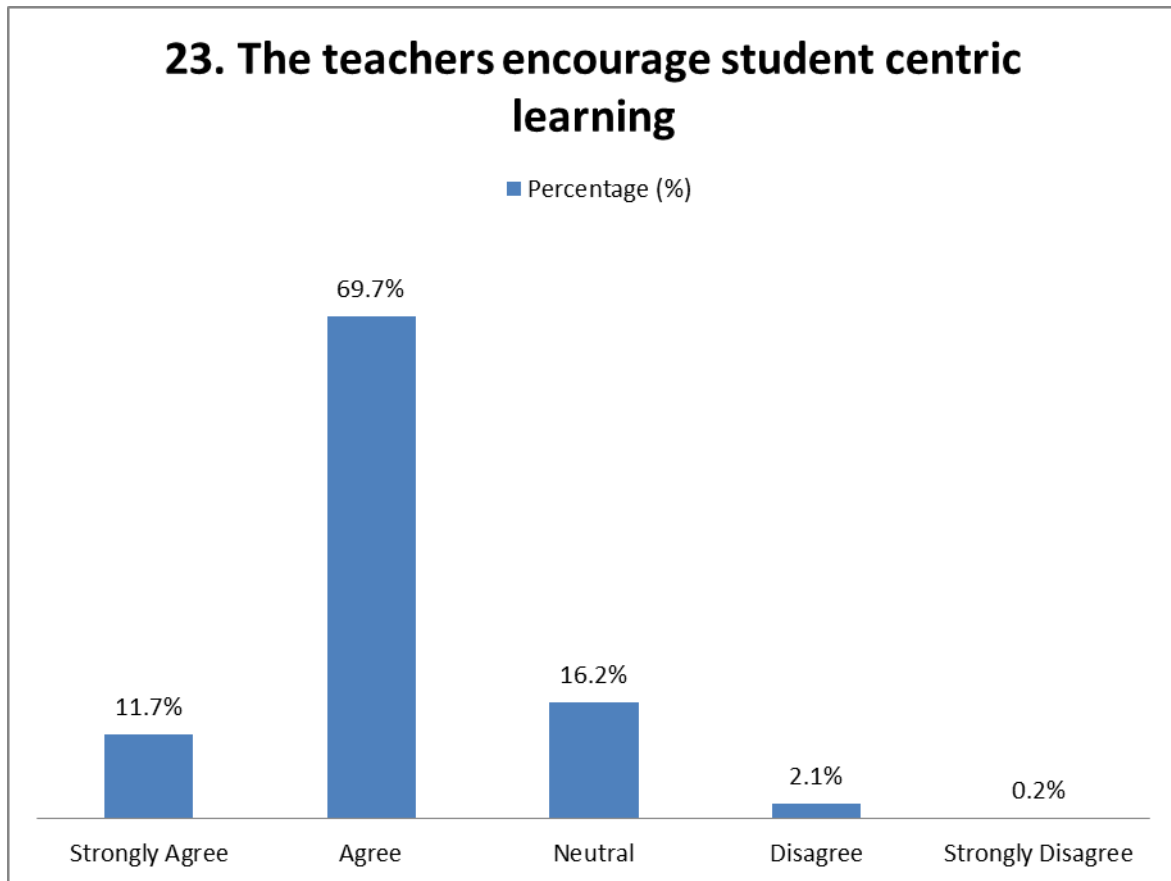


Figure 23: Whether the teachers encourage student centric learning

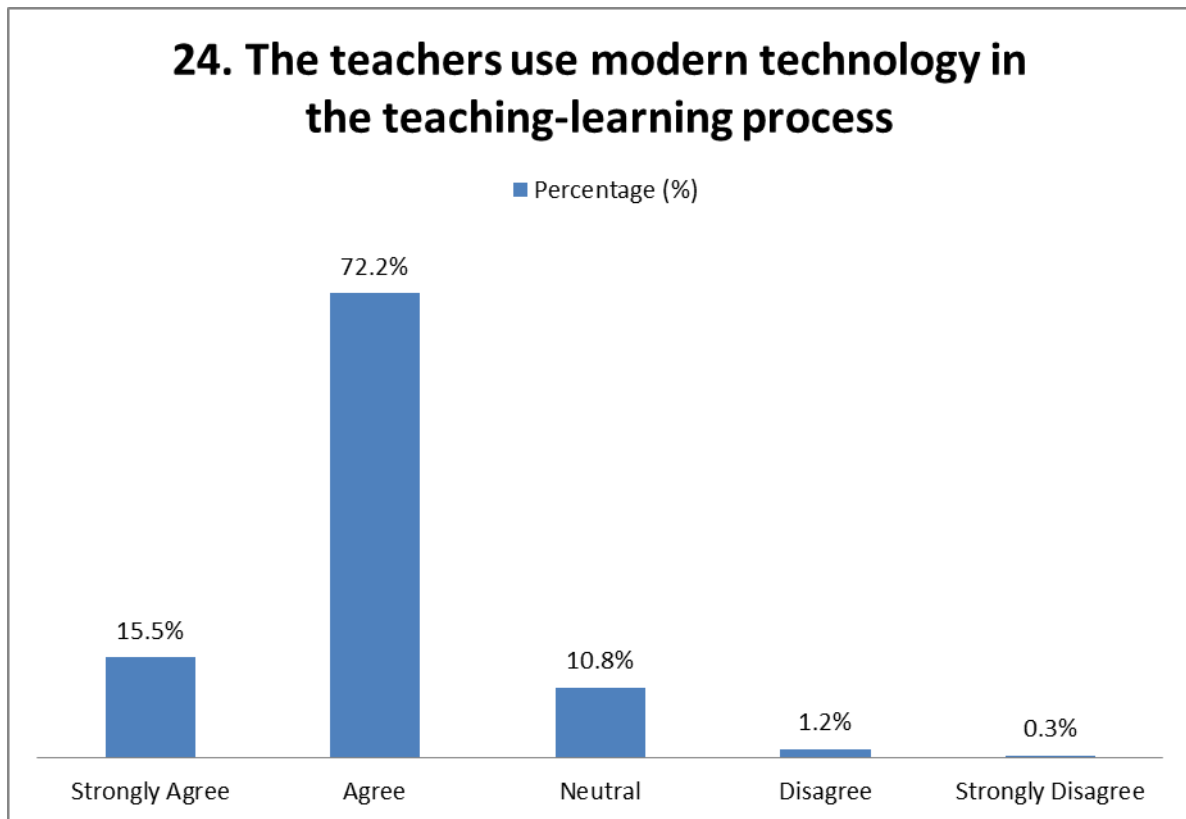


Figure 24: Whether the teachers use modern technology in the teaching-learning process

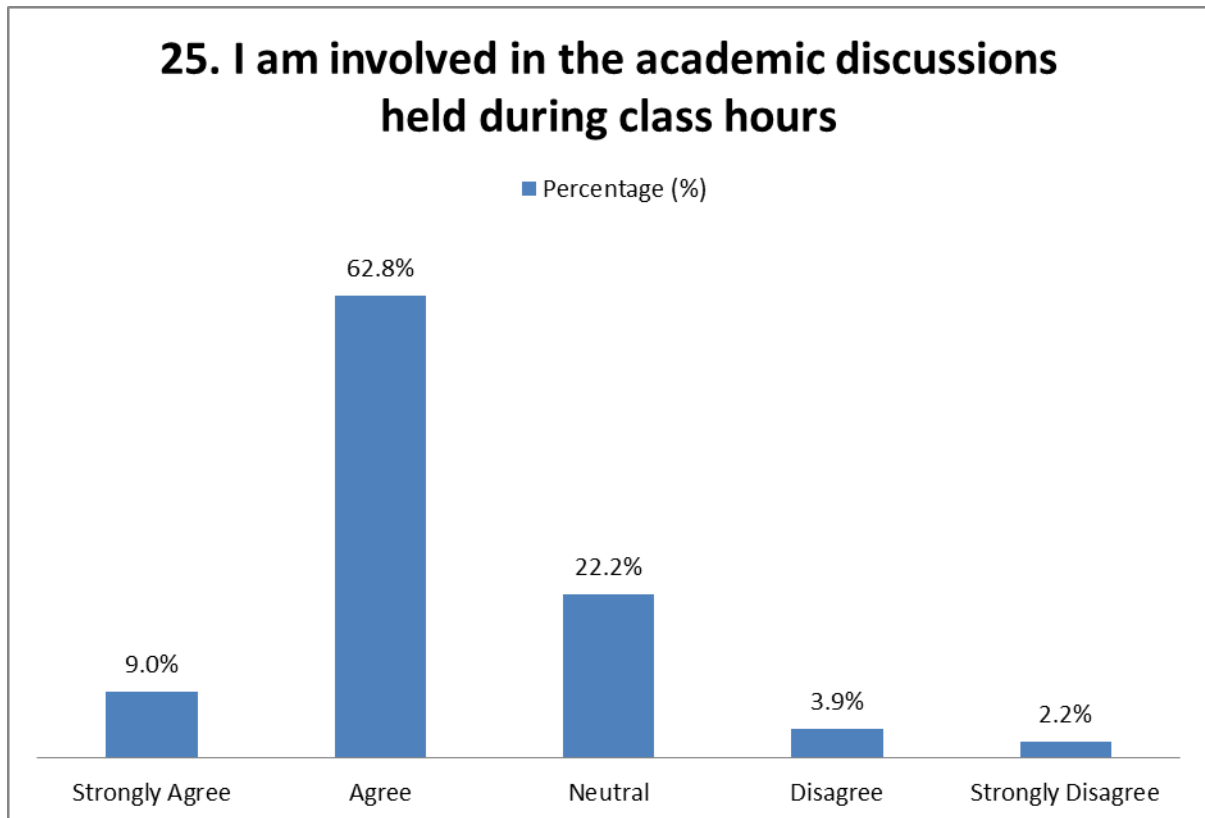


Figure 25: Whether involving in the academic discussions held during class hours

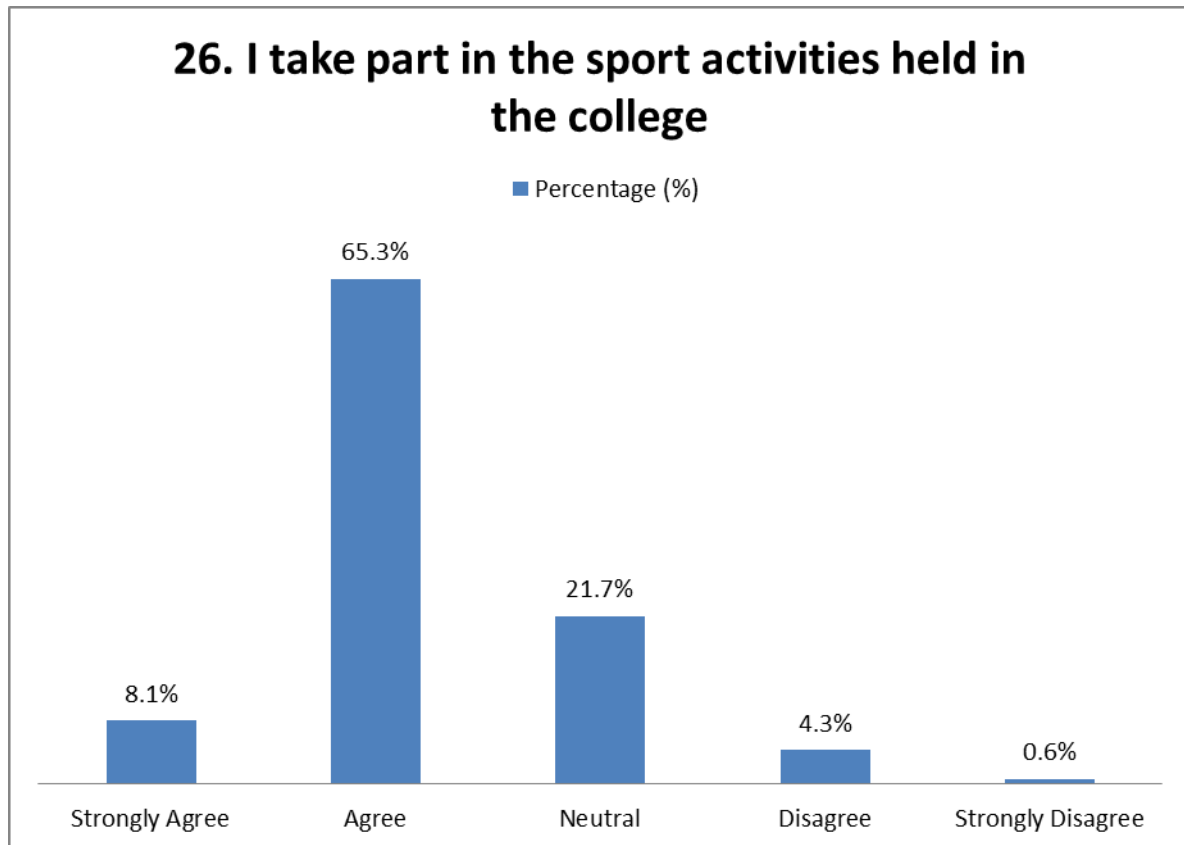


Figure 26: Whether taking part in the sport activities held in the college

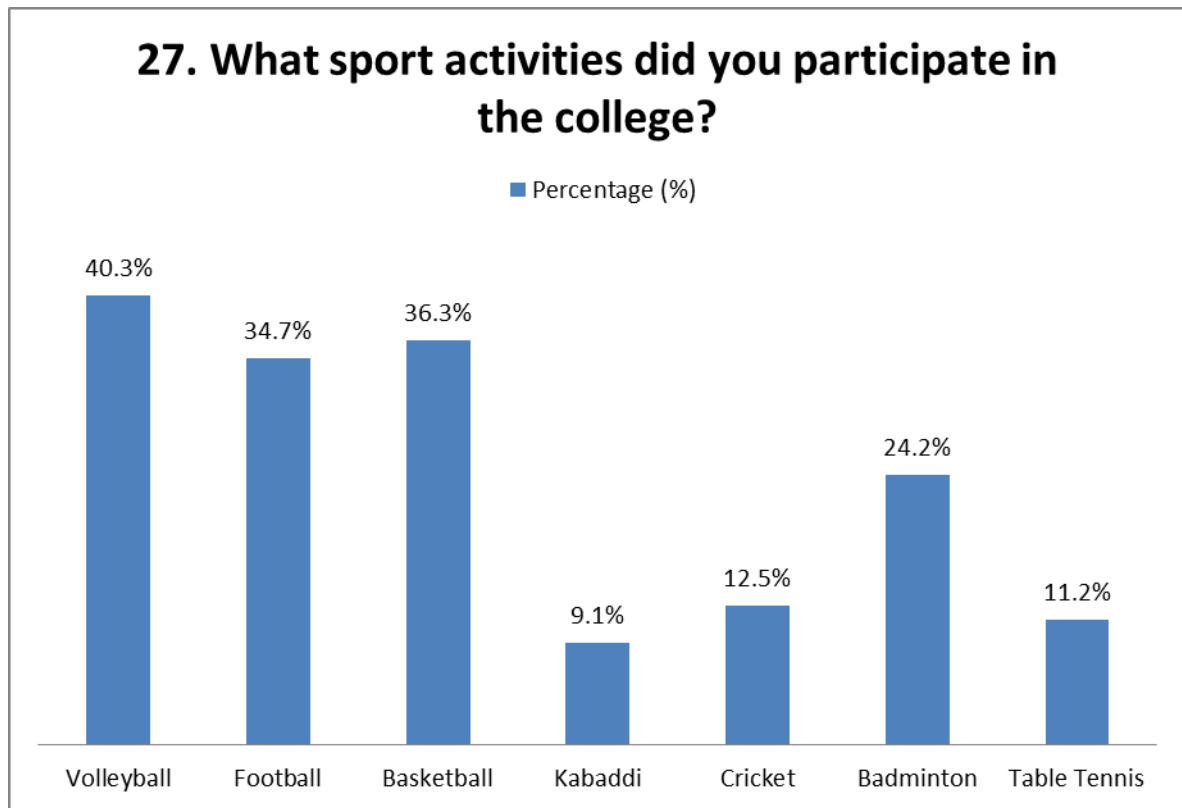


Figure 27: The sport activities participated in the college

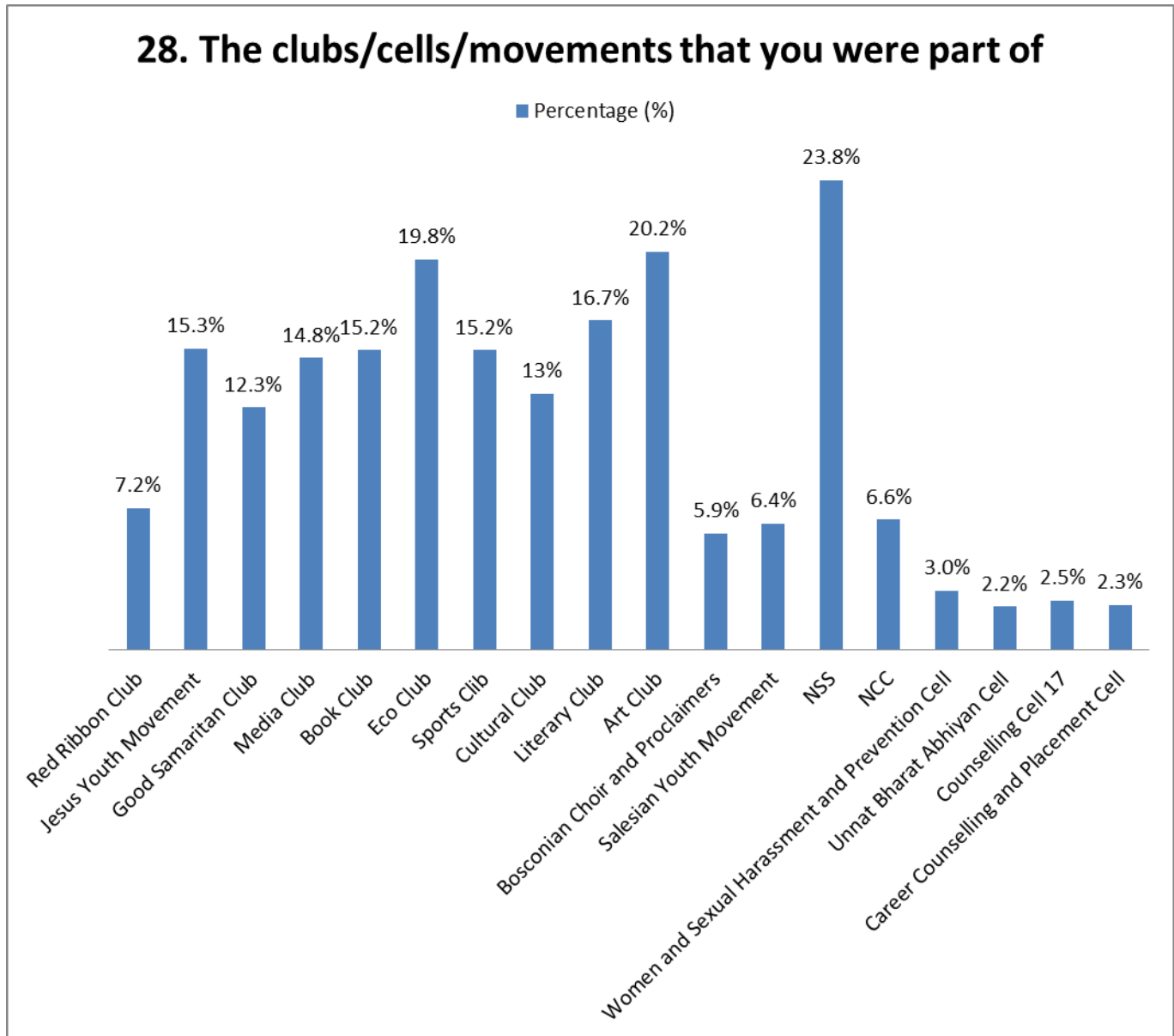


Figure 28: The clubs/cells/movements that the students were part of

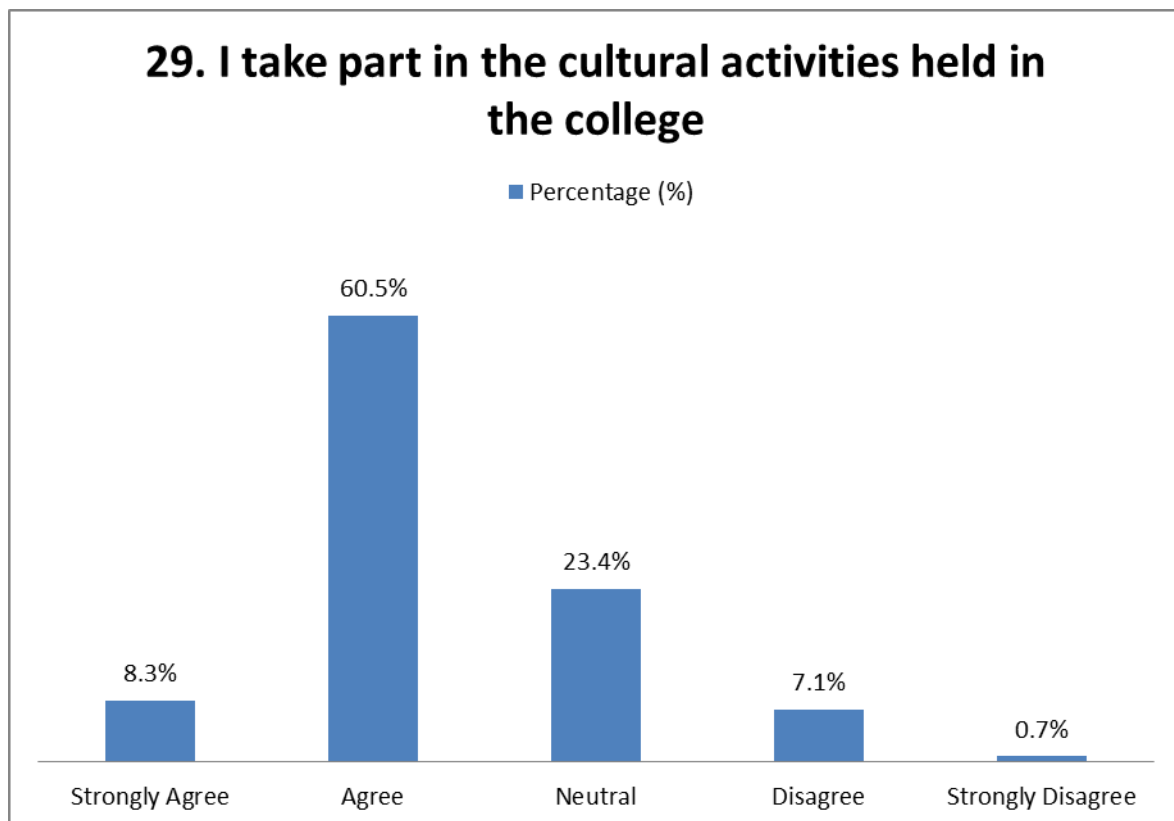


Figure 29: Whether taking part in the cultural activities held in the college

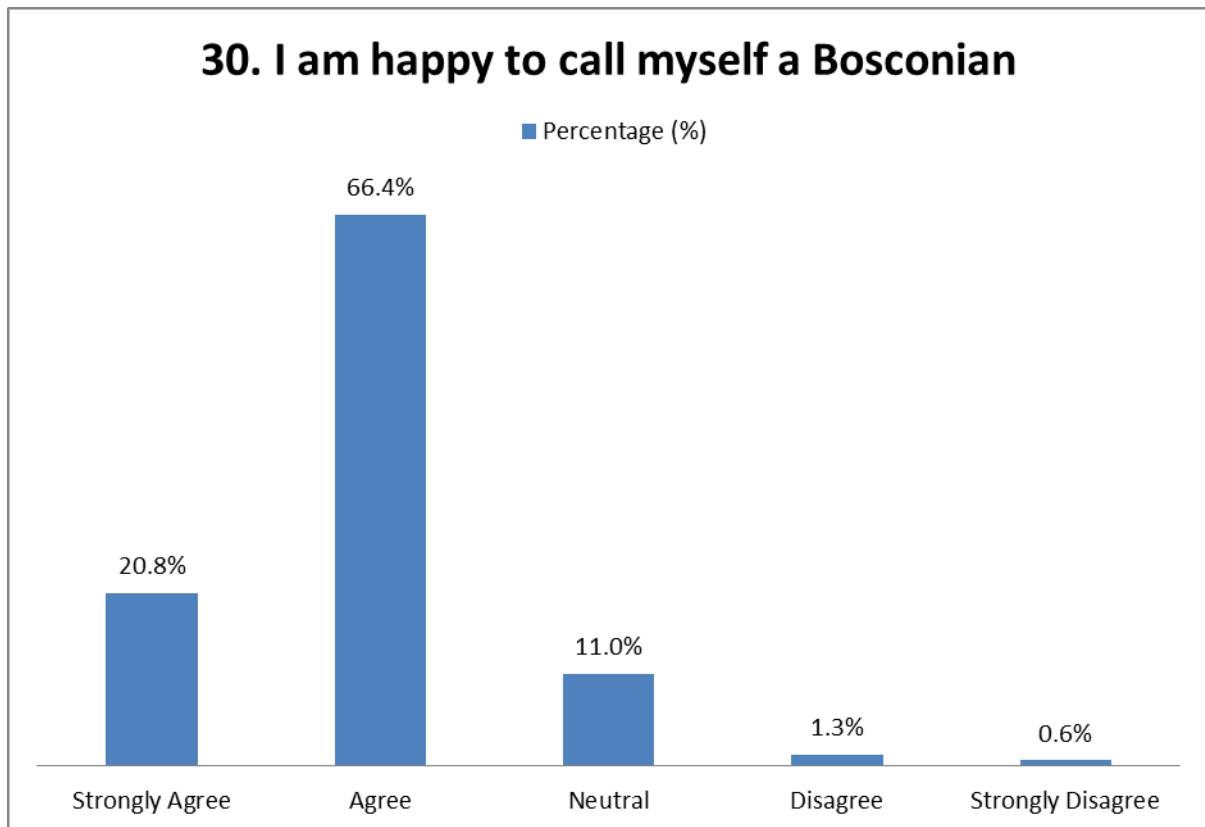


Figure 30: Whether happy to be called themselves as a Bosconian

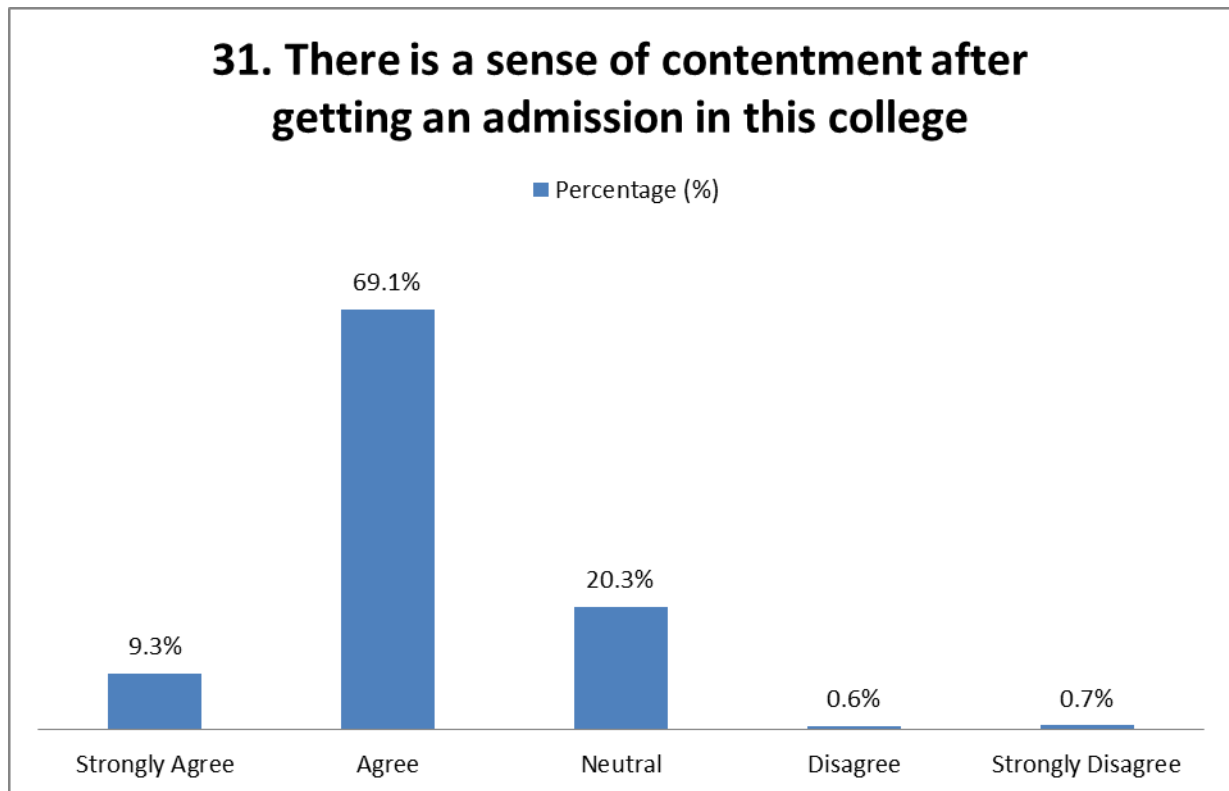


Figure 31: Whether there is a sense of contentment after getting an admission in this college

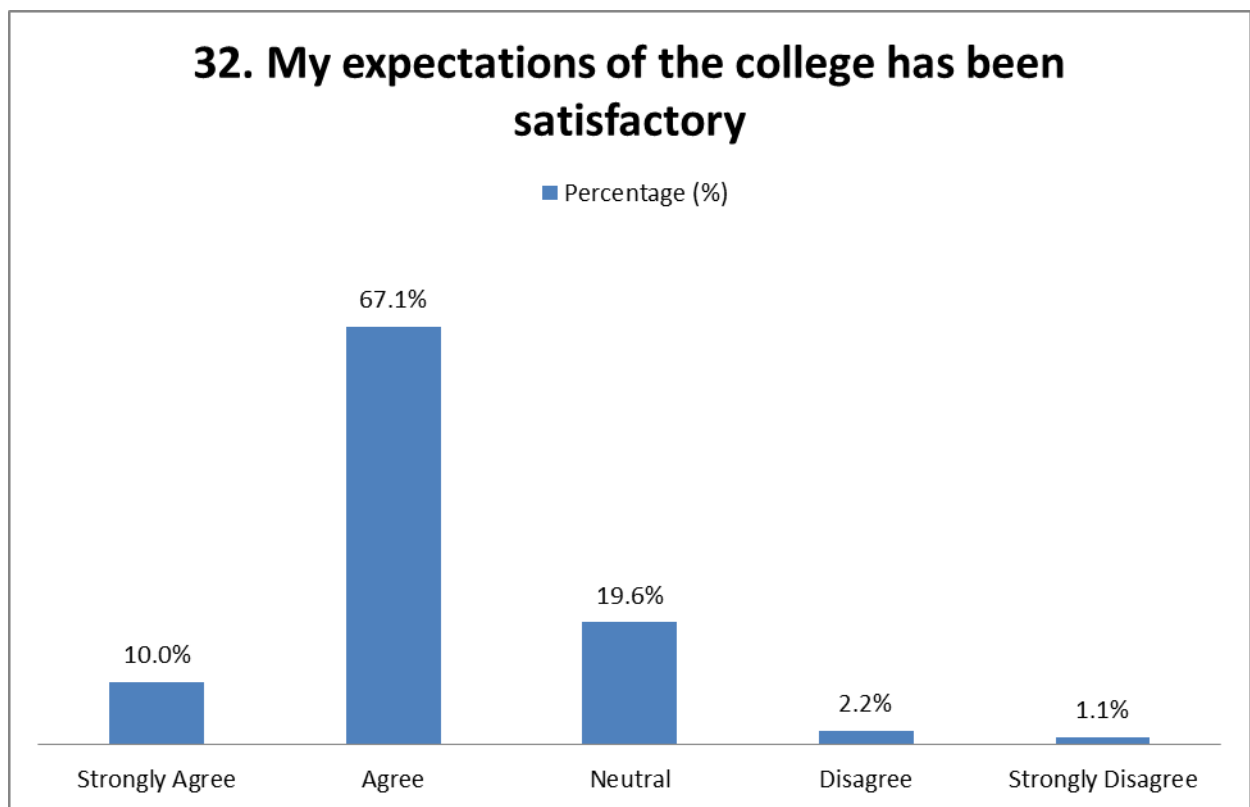


Figure 32: Whether your expectations of the college has been satisfactory

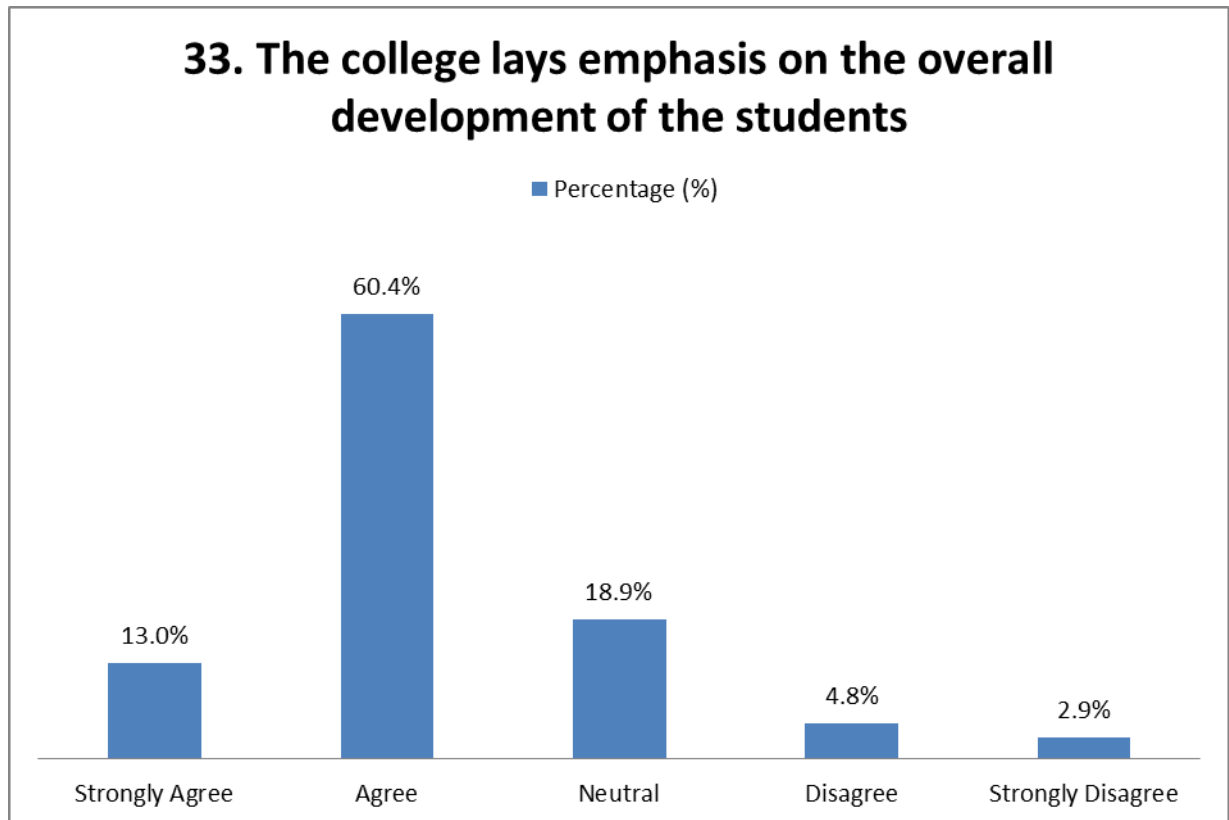


Figure 33: Whether the college lays emphasis on the overall development of the students
