I am extremely delighted to highlight them in my annual report.

A. EVENTS OF THE ACADEMIC CALANDER

Orientation Programme for Freshers

A two-day orientation programme was organized for the New Commers of the college on 8th and 9th August, 2023. This programme was animated by the DBYES team comprised of Dr. Fr. Salew Peter, Fr. Romeo Gangmei, Mr. Allan and Miss Khelika. The freshers were helped to know Don Bosco's method of education, know each other, overcome their inhibitions and acclimatize themselves to college life.

Teachers' Day

On 5th September, Teachers' Day was organized to felicitate and honour all the Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff of the college for their selfless contributions. The day was celebrated under the theme "Good Teachers are the reason why ordinary students dream to do extraordinary things".

Freshers' Day

Freshers' Day was organized on 9th September 2022 in the college to officially welcome the freshers to Don Bosco College, Itanagar. Altogether 553 students were admitted to the 1st Semester for the academic session 2022-2023.

Floral Tribute to Lt. Dr. Fr. Nicholas Guandiat (Former Principal)

Floral tribute was paid to Lt. Dr. Fr. Nicholas Guandiat, the former Principal of the college on 22 September, 2022 marking his 1st Death Anniversary. The management and the staff who collaborated with him paid a floral tribute during the Morning Assembly. Fr. Principal also highlighted the steps taken by Lt. Fr. Nicholas to take the college to greater heights.

College Week and Cultural & Food Fest

A week-long College week was celebrated from 5th to 12th November, 2022. The week was packed with various cultural, literary and sports events. Shri Takam Sanjay, Former Member of Parliament was the Chief Guest

for the Inaugural function. Shri Pasang Dorjee Sona, Hon'ble Speaker, Govt of Arunachal Pradesh was the Chief Guest and Shri Yumlam Kaha, Director for Social Justice, Empowerment and Tribal Affairs, was the Guest of Honour for the Valedictory Function. The Cultural Food Fest was part of the college week. Shri. Nakap Nalo, Hon'ble Minister, Tourism, Transport, Civil Aviation and Land Management, was the Chief Guest of the day and Dr. David Pertin, Joint Registrar, RGU was the Guest of Honour for the Cultural Food Fest.

Faculty Development Program

The End Semester Examinations for the Odd Semester took place between 5th to 24th December, 2022 and the Even Semester were held between 15th May to 6th June, 2023. All the examinations went well with strict vigilance, upholding the sanctity and seriousness of the examination.

Farewell for Outgoing Students

On 9th May the college organized farewell for the outgoing students. The day was celebrated under the theme, "Go Confidently in the direction of your dreams! Live the life you've imagined."-Thoreau. Awards were also handed over to the Best Class Captain (boy and girl) and Best Class.

Dr. Fr. Jose George (25 years of Religious Profession). The Eucharist was celebrated in the Assembly Hall, which was followed by Cultural extravaganza and meal. The program was organized by APCA.

NAAC Peer Team Visit

After three years of intense preparation, the long-awaited NAAC Peer Team Visit took place in our college on 23rd and 24th March 2023. The team consisted of Dr. Boda Venkat Rathnam (Former Vice Chancellor, Kakatiya University, Warangal) as the Chairman, Dr. Rabindra Kumar Mohanty (Professor and HoD, Sociology, Mizoram University) as Member Coordinator and Dr. Raghunath Misal (Former Principal, Annasaheb Magar Mahavidyalaya, Maharashtra) as member.

NAAC Accreditation with “A” Grade

On 30th March 2023, DBC received the happy news that the College was NAAC Accredited with “A” Grade, with a CGPA of 3.13. This was the 1st Cycle of NAAC Accreditation. Congrats to all the Faculty Members, Support Staff, Alumni, Students and Parents. God has blessed our hard work with excellent grade.

Gratitude Day

Accreditation by NAAC with A Grade called for celebration. Hence, 5th April 2023 was declared as gratitude day. The celebration took place in the college in the form of a short cultural program followed by Dinner. Representatives from various levels such as State, RGU, Alumni, Parents and well-wishers were part of the celebration.

Completion of Funded Research Projects

Two funded research projects were carried out and successfully completed by two faculty of our college during academic session 2022-2023. Dr. Tailyang Sirah Asst. Professor of the department of Sociology carried out the project titled “Empowerment Through Education: A Study of the Adi Tribe of East Siang District, Arunachal Pradesh”. ₹. 8.65 Lakhs was sanctioned to carry out this project. Another Project titled “Role of Education in Social Development Among Tribals of Arunachal Pradesh” was carried out by Dr. Namzidimbo Zeliang, Asst. Professor in the department of Political Science for which ₹9.06 Lakhs was sanctioned. The sponsoring Agency for the projects was Social Justice, Empowerment and Tribal Affairs, Tribal Research Institute, Government of Arunachal Pradesh.

C. OTHER ACTIVITIES OF THE COLLEGE

Notable Events at College

1. Women’s Cell of Don Bosco College, Itanagar organized “International Women’s Day” on 7th March 2023 on the theme, “Digit ALL: Innovation and Technology for Gender Equality. The Resource Person of the day was Dr. Duyu Meena Mudang, Senior Medical Officer, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh.
2. The sports club of the college organized its 2nd Bosco Badminton Trophy on 8th and 9th March, 2023. Altogether 31 players participated in the tournament.
3. “Honesty Shop” was inaugurated for the students of Don Bosco College Itanagar on 15th March 2023. This initiative was launched by the Department of Commerce with the aim of inculcating trust, honesty and integrity. It was inaugurated by Dr (Fr.) Jose George, the Principal of Don Bosco College, in the presence of Vice Principals, HoDs of every department along with students of the department of Commerce.

Workshops and Awareness Programmes

1. The NSS volunteers organized awareness rally on “Har Ghar Tiranga” at Jollang village on August 10, 2022. The volunteers distributed the Indian flag to the public especially the shopkeepers, cleaned the village church and the statue of Don Bosco located adjacent to the main road.
2. A One-day Awareness Programme was conducted for the students of our college by the Career Guidance & Placement Cell in collaboration with the Chief Election Officer Office, Itanagar on the theme, “Linking of AADHAR with Elector’s Photo Identity Card” at College Auditorium on 23rd September 2022.
3. The Career Guidance & Placement Cell and Women’s Cell in collaboration with the SP Office, PHQ, Itanagar also conducted a programme on the theme “Sensitization on Police Functioning” on 12th October 2022 at College Auditorium.
4. The NSS Units of DBC conducted Swachchata Campaign at Jollang river on 19th October. The Gram Panchayat Chairman of Jollang Panchayat, Shri Tana Taha Tara, visited the site and verified the work done by the volunteers. 250 Kgs of plastic waste were collected from the river and was disposed of using the Panchayat Garbage Truck.
5. A two-day workshop on Participatory Rural Appraisal (PRA) was conducted on 3rd February 2023 for the students of BSW IV & VI Semesters. Mr. Liamkham Afi, Block Mission Manager, Doimukh, ArSRLM and Mr. Dodum Natung, Block Assistant, MIS, Doimukh, ArSRLM were the Resource Persons.
6. A One-day Career Guidance-cum-Interaction programme was conducted by Career Guidance & Placement Cell for final semester students in collaboration with Rajagiri College, Kerala on 18th April 2023, with the aim to help students make right choice for their higher studies.
7. The Women Cell of our college conducted a one-day awareness programme on “Menstrual Hygiene” on 1st May 2023 in BPL colony, Jollang, Itanagar. The programme aimed to spread awareness on the need for menstrual hygiene rights for women and to break stigma about menstruation by providing access to menstrual health education. The student members distributed 50 sanitary pads in the area and delivered awareness on the importance of menstrual hygiene to the locals.

Camps

1. A five-day Rural Camp was held on the theme “Strengthening Social Connectedness” from 5th to 10th February, 2023 at Jotte Village for the IV and VI semester BSW students to provide them exposures to rural life, problems and issues related to rural life.
2. The NSS volunteers had their Annual Special Camp for the Academic Session 2022-23 at the adopted slum, Below Poverty Line Colony, Jollang from 10th to 16th April, 2023.
3. The Red Ribbon Club organized a Voluntary Blood Donation Camp in collaboration with Tomo Riba Institute of Health and Medical Sciences (TRIHMS) Naharlagun, in the college premises on 29th April 2023. Eight medical team members from TRIHMS headed by Dr. Tashi Paleng, BCMO, came for the service. The camp witnessed a huge success with a collection of 78 units of blood.

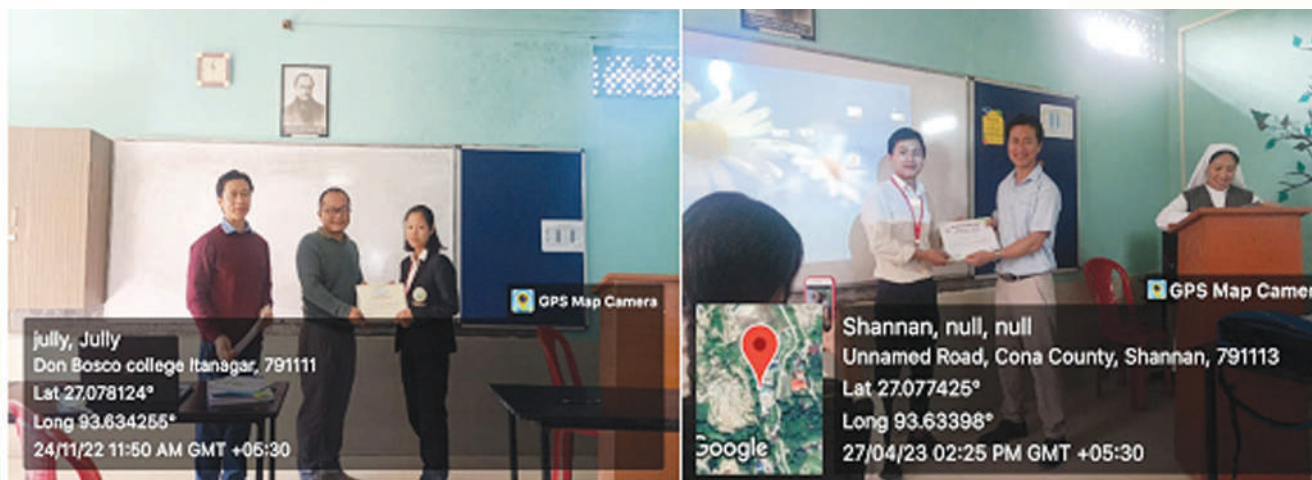

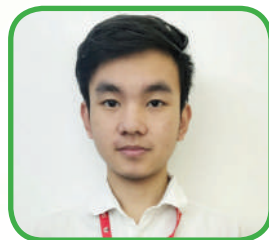

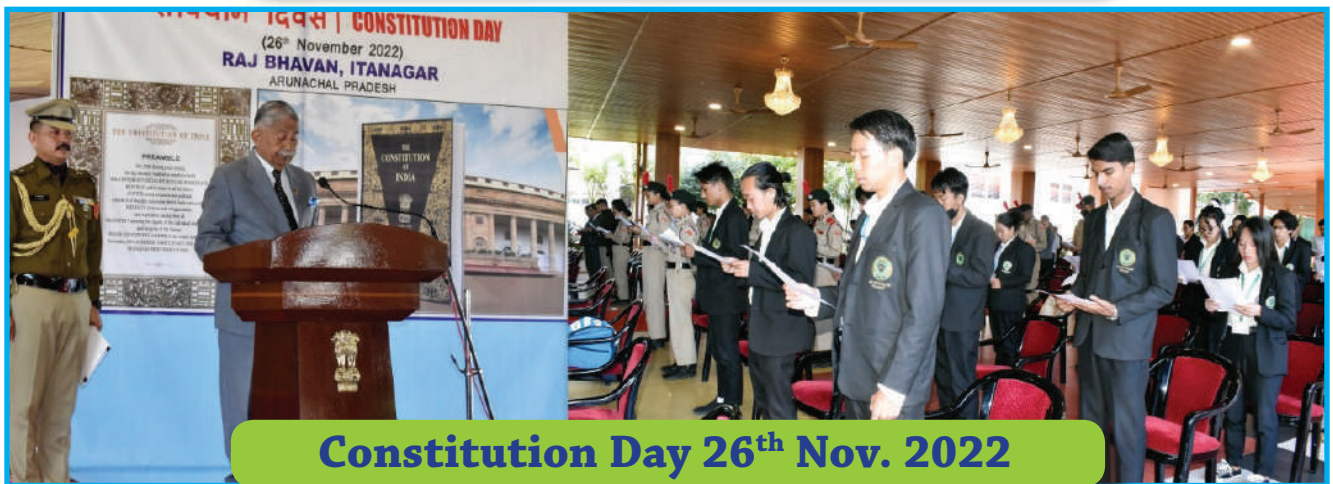

BOOK CLUB

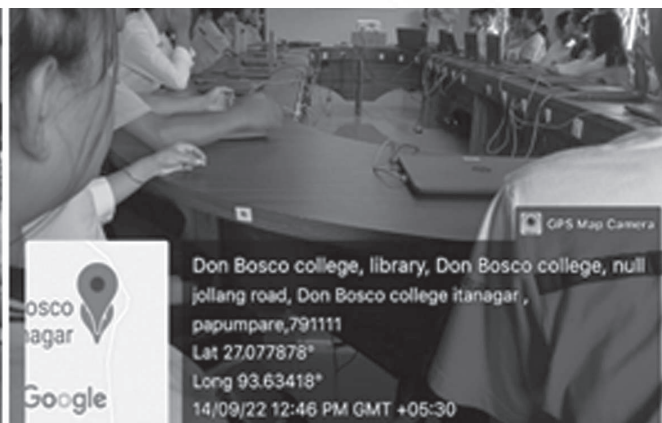

The collection and development of print/ non-print media began in 2010 and since then, accumulated adequate number of books, journals, e-books and e-journals, etc. Having a website of its own and adopting new emerging tools like Web 2.0 tools, QR Code and CCTV, etc., the library has been growing without limit. Don Bosco College Central Library has adopted "Open Access System." The library has fully automated and facilitated computerized Catalogue Search Services through Koha Web OPAC (Web Online Public Access Catalogue).

Library Services:

a. Circulation & Book Lending

- a. Two Library cards are issued to each student for a validity of 3 years. 3 Library cards are issued to the fifth and sixth semester students and 4 Library Cards for faculty. (One Card One Book)
- b. A library book issued can be retained for a period 07 days for students & 15 Days for faculty. If the user wants to retain the books beyond 07/15 days, he/she has to renew the books.

Activities for the session 2022-23

During the academic year 2022 – 2023, Sr. Lellis was appointed as one of the Counsellors in place of Sr. Pauline Mary, who was transferred from Itanagar for her vocational work. A total number of 321 students attended the counselling sessions- 170 girls and 151 boys. Most of the students who sought counselling sessions were related to fear, stress, family issues, substance abuse, and examination tension. Students also shared their stress, anxiety and worries about their future careers.

Some of the common issues faced by the students:

- Problems in studies like lack of concentration
- Absenteeism and fear of examination
- Adjustment to the system and coping skills
- Decision-making and lack of self-confidence

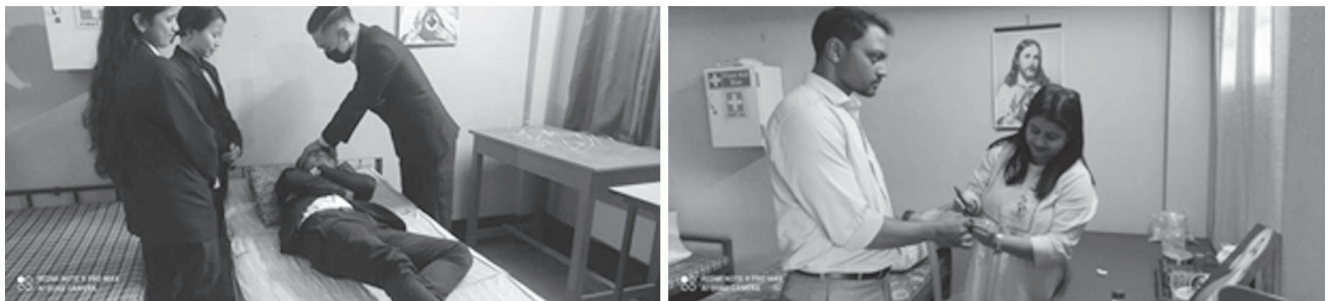

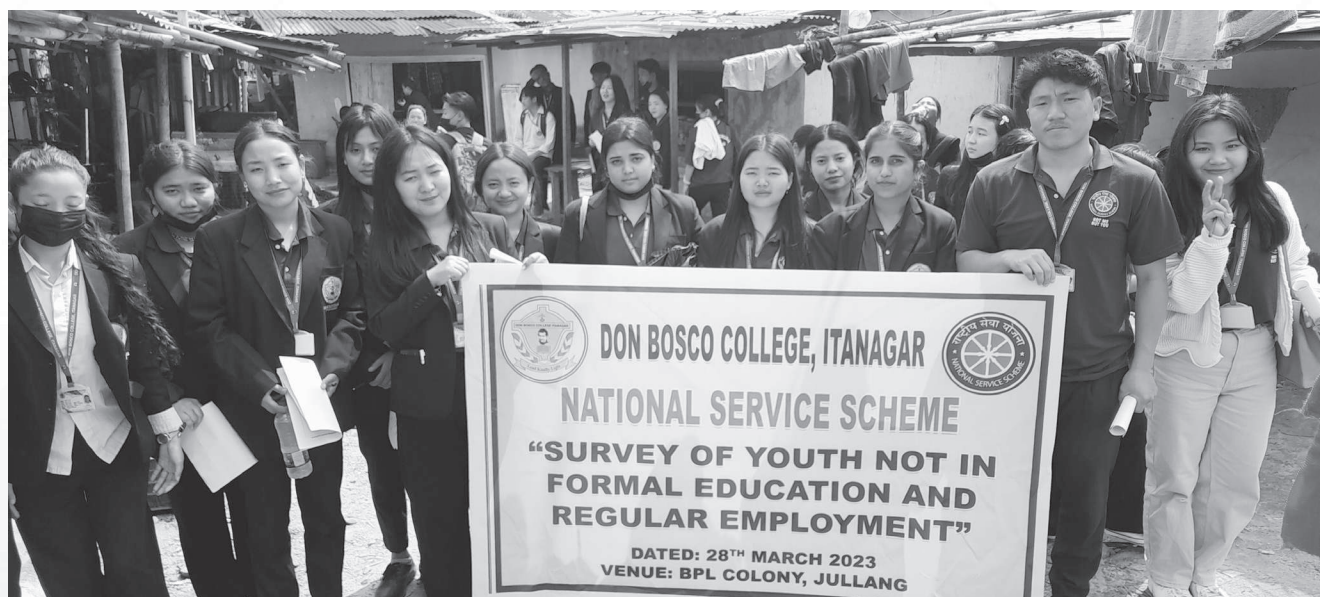
