Discussions of the Meeting

The meeting began with a review of the anti-ragging initiatives and activities undertaken during the previous academic year. It was noted that the awareness campaigns, orientation programmes and counseling sessions had a positive impact on creating a safer environment on campus. The need for more data collection and evaluation to measure the effectiveness of these initiatives was emphasized. The coordinator presented an outline of the annual plan for the Anti-Ragging Cell for the session 2023-24. Discussion ensued regarding the distribution of responsibilities among the members. Mr. Daikho Athisu, Coordinator of the previous year apprised that so far, the Cell

has not received any complaints. The Principal advised to consider incorporating interactive activities in workshops to engage students more effectively. Explore the possibility of creating online resources and information hubs related to anti-ragging.

Decisions of the Meeting

1. To organize regular workshops and orientation Programs for incoming students to educate them about the college's policies on ragging and its consequences.
2. To launch a campus-wide poster campaign to reinforce the message against ragging and encourage reporting.
3. To strengthen the counseling services available for victims of ragging, providing them with a safe space to seek help.
4. Different members of the Cell would take up the responsibility of initiating and organizing different activities.
